In my parish, there was once a new employee who frequently told me she was sorry for various imperfections in her work. It could be a little tiring. I finally told her, "You know, you don't have to say 'sorry' so often." She looked me right in the eyes and said, "Father, you're right. I'm sorry." Her ear-to-ear grin betrayed that she enjoyed the irony — and that she would keep asking for forgiveness as often as she needed it.

The Gospel reading this week proclaims to us that God, in Jesus, delights in numerous requests for, and the granting of, forgiveness. To Peter's question, "**Lord, if my brother sins against me, how often must I forgive? As many as seven times?**" Jesus responds, "**I say to you, not seven times but seventy-seven times.**" In other words, Peter, stop counting.

Christian life should be marked by a commitment to frequent forgiveness. God never tires of forgiving us. His limitless love has overcome the power of vengeance, hatred, and division. We tap into that each and every time we ask for forgiveness or extend it to another.

How beautiful our hearts become when they become accustomed to frequent forgiveness! How joyful and attractive become our marriages, families, and parish communities! How light our souls feel when unburdened by the habit of keeping score.

Challenge: Name one thing, small or large, for which you could ask forgiveness from someone in your life. Then do it.

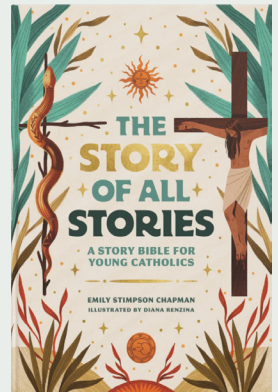

RESOURCE SPOTLIGHT: THE STORY OF ALL STORIES

Our children may know the story of Noah's Ark. They may recognize David and Goliath, know that Moses parted the Red Sea, and be able to tell us about Jesus' birth, miracles, Death, and Resurrection. But do they know how all of those stories fit together? The Bible isn't simply a collection of separate stories—it is one great story of God's love for His people. From Creation and the Fall, through Abraham, Moses, and David, all the way to Jesus Christ and the Church, God is continually revealing His plan of salvation.

A beautiful resource for helping children see this bigger picture is *The Story of All Stories: A Story Bible for Young Catholics*. Written especially for children ages 7–13, this Catholic story Bible walks through salvation history while helping young readers see how the Old Testament points forward to Jesus, Mary, the sacraments, and the life of the Church. Beautiful illustrations make it especially inviting for families to read together.



Consider adding a few minutes of Scripture to your family's routine—at the dinner table, before bed, or on a quiet Sunday afternoon. Read one story together and ask a simple question: "What does this teach us about God?" We want our children to know the individual stories of our faith, but even more importantly, we want them to know the Story—and to understand that it isn't only a story from long ago. **It is their story, too.** *The Story of All Stories* is available from Word on Fire and makes a wonderful resource for family prayer and faith formation.

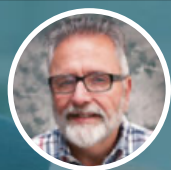
