Day 1: Arrival in Malindi – Welcome to the Adventure

- A 45-minute bus ride and 15-minute boat trip take you to an unspoiled lagoon with crystal-clear flat water.

- Full-day kiteboarding in untouched surroundings.
- Optional: Fresh local fish platter (EUR 10) or vegetarian lunch (EUR 5).

Day 4: The Big Downwinder – 40km of Pure Stoke

Date: Wednesday, 4 February 2026

Moon Phase: Waning Gibbous

Tide Times (10:00-18:00):

- Low tide: ~11:00 AM (0.35 m)
- High tide: ~5:44 PM (3.10 m)
- Start the day slow and enjoy lunch, then launch into a 40km downwinder from waves to mirror-flat waters.
- Your support crew meets you by bus with your gear at the destination.
- A truly epic ride straight to your next accommodation.

Day 5: Freestyle Heaven

Date: Thursday, 5 February 2026

Moon Phase: Waning Gibbous

Tide Times (10:00–18:00):

- Low tide: ~11:39 AM (0.33 m)
- High tide: ~5:44 PM (3.10 m)
- Spend the day at a perfectly flat water spot, ideal for tricks and progression.
- In the evening, a scenic 45-minute ride takes you to your next coastal base in Kilifi.

Day 6: Kilifi Kite & Culture

Date: Friday, 6 February 2026

Moon Phase: Waning Gibbous

Tide Times (10:00-18:00):

- Low tide: ~12:16 PM (0.38 m)
- High tide: ~6:24 PM (3.14 m)
- Short drive to the local kite club where you'll spend the day shredding Kilifi's pristine waters.
- Chill atmosphere, great vibes, and meals available at the club (lunch and dinner not included).
- Return to the same accommodation to rest and recharge.

Day 7: Diani – Coastline Cruising Begins

- Low tide: ~12:51 PM (0.48 m)

- High tide: ~7:03 PM (3.12 m)

- Early breakfast and 2-hour scenic transfer to Diani Beach.
- Lunch at your launch site, personal items sent ahead to the next base.
- Afternoon downwinder from Kongo to your beach accommodation, carving through reef waves.
- Evening: Relax and soak in the Diani magic.

Day 8: Diani - Galu Downwinder

- Low tide: ~1:26 PM (0.63 m)

- High tide: ~7:43 PM (3.04 m)

- Launch right from your doorstep and kite your way along the coastline to the stunning Galu Beach.
- Afternoon road trip back with breathtaking coastal views and good vibes all around.

Day 9: Villa Kite & Clean

Moon Phase: Third Quarter (~50%)

Tide Times (10:00-18:00):

- Low tide: ~2:01 PM (0.80 m)
- Relaxed day kiting at the villa.
- Clean and dry all kite gear in preparation for travel.
- Final evening to enjoy the beach and celebrate the journey.
