


THE BOMAS OF KENYA







The farm house is set within beautiful gardens surrounded by acres of tea and indigenous forest - home to the Colobus monkey. Ngong Hills Kenya are the peaks in a ridge along the Great Rift Valley, located southwest near Nairobi, in southern Kenya. The word "Ngong" is an Anglicization of a Maasai phrase "enkong'u emuny" meaning rhinoceros spring, and this name derives from a spring located near Ngong Town. For a spectacular hiking safari near Nairobi, head to the Ngong Hills, just a 40-minute drive away. The knuckle shaped hills offer the panoramic views of Nairobi and the surrounding mountain ranges, and you can choose to turn back at any point if you do not feel like scaling very peak (the highest rises to 8,071 feet above the sea level). The most great about hiking the Ngong Hills, takes about 4 to 5 hours depending on the fitness levels, is the satisfying of reaching the final peak is celebrated by the sprawling out on a blanket, enjoying a sandwich, and soaking in the views extending out from all sides.

Beyond its role as a living laboratory, the Nairobi Arboretum has evolved into a multifaceted resource for the city and its visitors. Managed by the Kenya Forest Service in collaboration with the Friends of Nairobi Arboretum (FONA). it serves a vital conservation area, a popular recreational space, and an invaluable educational resource. The nursery offers a range of activities, including walking trails, picnic areas, and bird-watching opportunities, making it a favorite destination for both locals and tourists. As a biodiversity hotspot within the urban landscape, it provides a habitat for various bird species and small mammals and functions as a crucial "green lung" for Nairobi, playing a significant role in the city's conservation efforts and environmental health.

Nairobi National Park is the first park to be gazetted in Kenya on December 16th 1946, the park is located about 7km (4.3mi) south of Nairobi in Kenya, and it's the only wildlife park in the world that is so close to the city. Nairobi National Park consists partly of thick woods near the city outskirts, partly of rolling plains and valleys, and partly of wooded confluence of several rivers, its vegetation is of the dry transitional savanna type. Acacias and other thorny varieties, muhuhu, Cape chestnut, and Kenya olive are the most important trees that acts as habitat for the wildlife in the park. Nairobi National park is the major rhino sanctuary for breeding and restocking other parks, the park is a home of over 100 mammal species having four of the Big five (lion, Buffalo, leopard, rhino) other animal species include the zebra, black rhinoceroses, giraffe, various species of antelope well as numerous reptiles and among others in the park to thrill while on Kenya wildlife Tours.

There are three trail bike depots: one on the KFEET grounds best accessible through Gate A (Limuru Road) or Gate D (off the end of the ICRAF access Road); a second rental point at Gate C (a.k.a. "Sharks") off Kiambu Road; and another at Gate F off Thigiri Ridge Road, the main entrance to Sigiria Gate. Please be prepared to leave your ID in safe-keeping with the bike shed staff and sign a disclaimer form before taking the bike.





The crater has an impenetrable forest and due to the nature of the terrain, Mt. Longonot has no roads and as such, visitors have to hike up and go round the rim of the crater to fully experience the sheer adventure of the great outdoors. The Mt. Longonot Hike is a thrilling trek up an extinct stratovolcano located about 60 kilometers from Nairobi in the Great Rift Valley. The trail starts at the Mt. Longonot National Park gate, where hikers pay an entrance fee before ascending the steep, dusty paths leading to the crater rim. The hike is approximately 9 kilometers round trip, but its steep inclines and high altitude make it a challenging adventure.

A high-altitude challenge with rolling hills, offering stunning views of the Rift Valley.



For safety, it is recommended to run in groups, as the area is patrolled by armed guards due to past security concerns. Whether for fitness, adventure, or scenic beauty, the Ngong Hills Running Trail is one of Kenya's most rewarding trail-running destinations.

LIMURU TEA FARMS

These trails feature well-maintained dirt roads and gentle hills, making them ideal for both casual joggers and endurance runners. The cool highland climate, fresh mountain air, and misty mornings create perfect running conditions, while the endless stretches of lush tea fields provide a peaceful and picturesque backdrop. Runners can enjoy minimal traffic, soft terrain that's easy on the joints, and occasional sightings of local tea pickers at work. Early mornings and late afternoons offer the best experience, with stunning sunrise and sunset views over the Great Rift Valley. Whether training for long distances or simply enjoying a scenic jog, the Limuru Tea Farms Running Trails provide a unique and invigorating outdoor escape.

OLOOLUA NATURE TRAIL

A mix of forest paths, waterfalls, and caves, making for a scenic yet adventurous run.

Managed by the National Museums of Kenya, this 5-kilometer trail winds through towering trees, alongside a picturesque waterfall, caves, and a meandering stream, making it a favorite for nature lovers, hikers, and runners. The cool, shaded environment provides an ideal setting for relaxing walks, birdwatching, and picnics, while the well-maintained paths cater to both beginners and experienced trekkers. Visitors can explore the historic Oloolua Cave, which was once used by the Mau Mau freedom fighters, or relax by the 40-foot waterfall, one of the trail's highlights. The tranquil atmosphere, combined with the fresh forest air, makes Oloolua a perfect spot for weekend getaways, fitness runs, or quiet meditation in nature.

TIGONI HIGHLANDS RUNNING ROUTE

Cool temperatures and scenic rolling hills make this a favorite among marathon trainers.

The cool mountain air, misty mornings, and panoramic views of tea farms make it one of the most refreshing running spots in Kenya. With low traffic, soft terrain, and a peaceful rural atmosphere, the Tigoni Highlands Running Route is ideal for both recreational joggers and professional athletes looking to train at altitude. The route can be customized to different distances, from short 5K runs to longer endurance trails extending into Limuru. Early morning and late afternoon are the best times to run, offering spectacular sunrises and sunsets over the rolling hills. Whether for fitness, marathon training, or simply enjoying the beauty of the Kenyan highlands, Tigoni provides one of the most scenic and rewarding running experiences near Nairobi.
