Each year KidSafe Collaborative presents **awards** for **outstanding service and advocacy** to individuals or groups who have excelled by improving the **safety and well-being of children**, **youth and families in our community**.

We rely on people like you to nominate those who are deserving of recognition for their exemplary work!

Award Categories

Outstanding Professional Award:

An individual with *over ten years* of professional experience demonstrating outstanding service toward improving the safety and well-being of children/youth in our community.

. Promising Professional Award:

An individual with *fewer than ten years* in the field of children's services or related field, who has excelled in improving the safety and well-being of children, youth and families and demonstrates promise in their future work.

Outstanding Volunteer Award:

An individual who volunteers his/her time and service, and through their volunteer work has improved the safety and well-being of children, youth and families in our community.

Gregory Packan Children's Advocacy Award:

An individual who has advocated strongly and diligently on behalf of child/youth victims of abuse and neglect.

Outstanding Collaboration Award:

A **multi-disciplinary** group or team working together *across agencies and disciplines* to benefit children and families - *working together* to improve child/youth safety and well- being.

Janet S. Munt Prevention Award:

An individual or group working to promote prevention/early intervention services to strengthen families, prevent child maltreatment, and improve the health, safety and well-being of children and youth in our community.

Lifetime Achievement Award:

An individual who has dedicated <u>20 or more</u> years of outstanding service and has made a significant impact on the safety and well-being of children, youth and families in our community.

- * KidSafe Collaborative's work is focused primarily in *Chittenden County Vermont*. Nominees who serve in a state-wide capacity may be considered as long as a significant portion of their work/volunteerism takes place in and is dedicated to this community.
- * KidSafe Collaborative may present an award in a category other than the nomination indicates.
- * KidSafe Collaborative may elect to not present awards in all categories each year.

General Criteria for KidSafe Collaborative Award Nominations

To be eligible for an award, the person or persons nominated should be working or volunteering in an organization where their contribution actively promotes the mission of KidSafe Collaborative:

working *together* to improve our community's prevention of and response to child abuse and neglect.

Award nominees should demonstrate outstanding achievement in each of these areas:

- Activities/Achievements: Nominee's exemplary professional work or volunteer service and outstanding accomplishments have significantly helped to make a difference in improving the safety, health and well-being of children in our community.
- Leadership/Initiative: Nominee has shown outstanding leadership and initiative in developing or enhancing programs and services, and/or has implemented new promising approaches to improve the safety, health and well-being of children and families.
- Collaboration: Nominee has constructively engaged with community partners and has worked collaboratively with others across agencies and disciplines to improve children's safety and well-being.
- Making a Difference/Inspiration: Nominee's outstanding work or volunteer service has made a significant and lasting impact on improving the safety and wellbeing of children. The nominee inspires others in the field through their work and/or volunteerism.
