- Nyani Cultural Village Roots of Rhythm performance.
- Blyde River Canyon boat cruise & farewell stargazing dinner.

Day 10: Return via Panorama Route

- Stops at God's Window, Bourke's Luck Potholes, The Pinnacle.
- Drop-off at OR Tambo Airport by 5 p.m.
