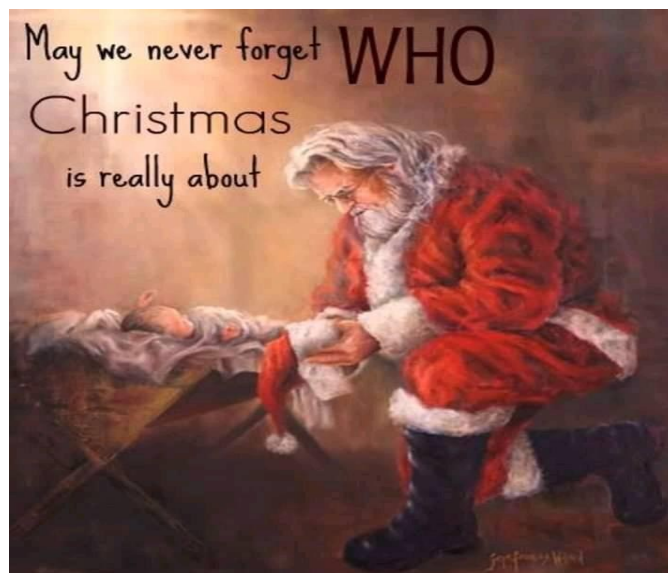

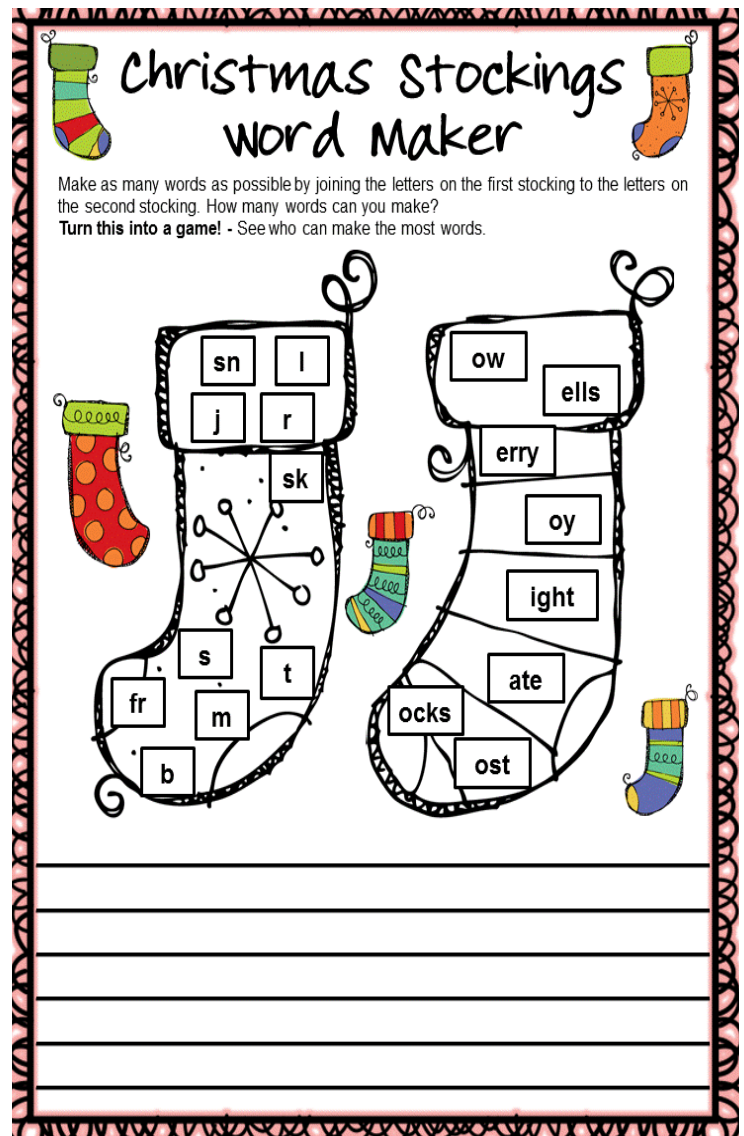

Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day

Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day seeks to **honor the victims of Japan's attack on Pearl Harbor**, an American Naval Station. The attack is often cited as the catalyst for American involvement in the Second World War, given that **President Franklin D. Roosevelt declared war on Japan** the following day.

At 8am on December 7th, 1941, without prior warning, the Imperial Japanese Navy Air Service attacked a Naval Station at Pearl Harbor, located on Oahu, Hawaii. The base was attacked by 353 Japanese fighter planes. In total, 2,403 people perished, another 1,178 were injured, four U.S. Navy battleships were sunk and 188 aircrafts were destroyed. On November 21, 2018 **Ray Chavez**, the **oldest U.S. military survivor** of the Pearl Harbor attack **died**. **He was 106.**

Snow Balls in a Jar

Ingredients:

- 1/2 cup confectionery sugar
- 2 cups all purpose flour
- 1 cup chopped pecans



Directions:

- In a medium bowl, combine the confectioners' sugar and flour. Place into a 1 quart canning jar. Put the chopped pecans on top. Close the lid and attach a tag with the following instructions:
- Snow Balls, Makes 4 dozen. Preheat the oven to 325 degrees F (165 degrees C). Grease cookie sheets. In a medium bowl, cream together 3/4 cup of shortening and 1/4 cup of margarine. Stir in 2 teaspoons of vanilla. Add the entire contents of the jar, and mix well. Roll dough into 1 inch balls and place them on the prepared cookie sheet. Bake for 20 to 25 minutes, until lightly browned. Cool, and roll in confectioners' sugar.

PS: These also make great desserts for holiday.

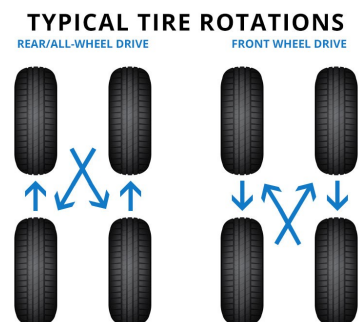
Do you really need to rotate your tires?

Even tire wear is also important for balanced handling. There is another important reason for rotating the tires on a regular schedule: The tire maker may require it to keep its warranty in force.
