6. FSCS Update/Tri-Parish Leadership Meeting 2/3/26 Ann Hoey
  - Ann Hoey, Andrew Elm and our FSCS board members (Danny Kieffer & Pat McNulty), Elizabeth McCanna, Bridget Adler & Peter Guzulaitis attended.
  - Catherine Butel (FSCS Principal) gave school update on Lumen Accreditation. Kate Larsen (Enrollment & Marketing Director) shared 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary video. John Tauer (FSCS Corporate Treasurer) gave financial update.
  - FSCS has received Lumen Accreditation, as part of Diocesan-wide effort to align academic accreditation with Catholic values.
  - Lumen evaluates 9 areas: Academic Achievement & Integration, Virtue Formation & Human Development, Spiritual Life, Apostolic Discernment, United

with Archdiocese & Parishes, Effective Governance, Leadership & Teaching, Access, Partnership Engagement & Financial Sustainability (69 areas evaluated in these 9 categories).

**Commendations:** Stable/unified community, strong teaching/academic protocols/success in institutional initiative

**Recommendations:** increase leadership support for academics & succession planning, increase capacity to meet diverse student needs, enrich the spiritual formation of both students & faculty.

- FSCS is in a search for a new school principal. The archdiocese leads the effort in conjunction with a search team from the school. Please pray for the process and the school.
- To bring visibility to the school at St Peter's, Anne has proposed to update the FSCS bulletin board by our drinking fountain. Fr Steven agrees and Anne will reach out to Kate Larson.

- Archbishop Hebda had a gathering with all priests, and a follow-up with all leadership to roll out a new initiative on 'Parents as Primary Educators'.
- Archbishop's pastoral letter Called "Only One Thing is Necessary ~ How Catholic Families Can Strive to be United in This Life and The Next" will be distributed across parishes.
  - We are asking that parish leadership start reading it
  - We will assign sections for our future meetings
  - It highlights areas of Catholic life, and how we can encourage and support one another.
  - Each parish will discern what this looks like in their community.
