AUGUST FUN FACTS:

- ** August's traditional flowers are the gladiolus and the poppy.

What we are learning: We are currently studying the pattern for The Body of Christ, which is based upon God's heavenly pattern of His Temple described at Hebrews 8:5. Every temple pattern ALWAYS reflects a picture of Christ.

In Revelation Chapters 1 through 3, Jesus Christ is depicted as the High Priest in The Temple of God who faithfully tends God's Lampstand to ensure that each lamp burns its brightest during the darkness of the night. The seven lamps on the lampstand are identified as seven prominent churches in Asia at the time of John's letters. However, don't forget that ALL the lamps TOGETHER represent The Lampstand of God, so this picture is not just about Asia's churches, it is about The Body of Christ.

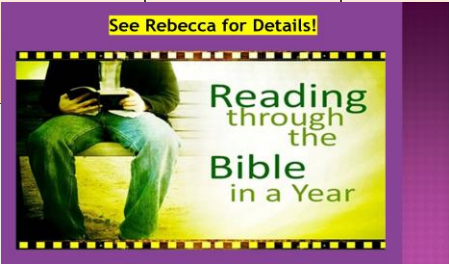
The Letters to the Seven Churches of Asia:

Apostle John is instructed to send a personalized letter to each church. But how should WE look at these letters? I've come to think of these letters as "report cards" on how each of us is doing in our walk with Christ. Look at EVERY LETTER as your own personal report card. Try to make a personal connection to each letter.

Each letter will have: (1) commendations for good work; (2) admonishments for poor work, including its remedies and its consequences; and finally, (3) the reward for those who overcome these admonishments. We tend to have a blind eye about our own shortcomings, so I urge you to study every letter. The point of these letters is that God wants us to SHINE BRIGHTLY as a testimony for His Son Jesus Christ, and these letters identify the things that get in the way of that.

Our Great High Priest knows our hearts and our works, and He trims each wick so that our lives display a brighter light for Him. Cherish these letters and be strengthened, because each one is written to you. Selah.

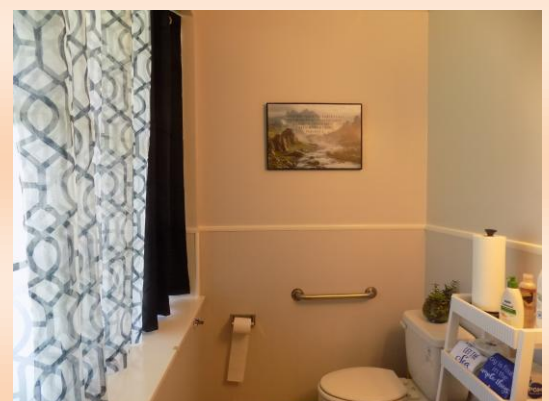
