## Music Ministry - Rebecca Virgen



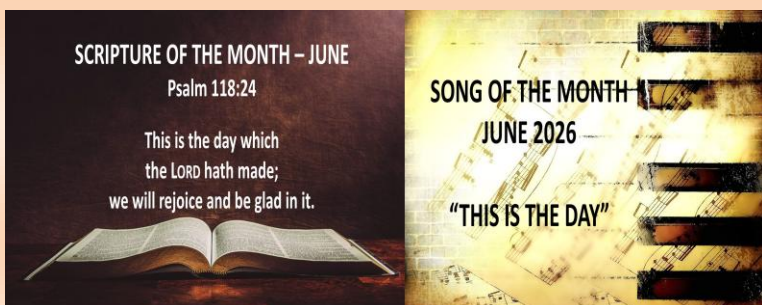

## LADIES BIBLE STUDY- Bonnie Vidal

### What we are learning:

God's heavenly pattern described at [Hebrews 8:5](#) is the basis of our study. In the weeks ahead, we will be winding up our current study on the pattern called **The Body of Christ**. Jesus had advised his disciples that He would come again, so in Apostle Paul's letters to the Thessalonians, he writes to the churches about a rumor that this event has already occurred. In these epistles, Paul consistently explains that God has an "an order" for all things, and the Second Coming of Christ is no different. We should contrast the **Coming Man of Lawlessness** with the second **Coming of The Lord**.

[2 Thessalonian 2:3](#) gives us insight into this order: (1) The Rebellion of lawlessness comes first; (2) then the Man of Lawlessness is revealed; and (3) then the Coming of The Lord. [Verses 6-7](#) reveal that lawlessness is in fact already at work, but it is currently be restrained by someone—the Holy Spirit who dwells in every follower of Christ. [Verses 9-11](#) describe the activities of the Man of Lawlessness which help to identify him: He is Satan's man, having all power, false signs and wonders, with wicked deception (*see [Exodus 7:11-13](#); like Pharaoh's sorcerers confronting Moses*). This man will deceive many, and God will let him because the people have rejected the Truth that God has revealed to them. Additional clues about this man are given at [Verse 4](#), "*who opposes and exalts himself against every so-called god or object of worship, so that he takes his seat in the temple of God, proclaiming himself to be God.*" [Zechariah Chapter 14](#) provides more details about "*the coming day of the Lord,*" when all the nations are subdued, and the Lord is king.

In the church there is wide discussion on [1 Thessalonians 4:13-18](#) where Paul talks about another "order" of things to come—when Christ comes for His people. Although there are different views on the coming tribulation that Jesus himself spoke about, we should be encouraged that no matter when or what happens as we live or die, on **that day** Christ will gather His followers to be with Him. Selah.
