



Spring Is Here!

Welcome to March! This month is all about growth. As the flowers begin to grow, we are focusing on how we can grow closer to God and sprout new habits of kindness and prayer. What better time to grow and learn than spring season!

FUN FACTS:

- * March is named after Mars, the Roman god of war. In Roman times, March was the first month in the Roman's 10-month calendar year.
- * Aquamarine is March's birthstone. The stone has a light sea blue hue. "Aqua" means water in Latin and "marina" means sea.
- * Daffodil is the flower of March due to the theme of winter ending and the new season of spring beginning. Daffodils are one of the first flowers to bloom after winter.
- * The Spring Equinox occurs around March 20th, The sun is directly overhead the equator and explains why it is one of the two days a year when day and night are the same duration!



IMPORTANT DATES:

- * March 5--Ash Wednesday is the official start of Lent season. Lent is the 40-day period (excluding Sundays) leading up to Easter. It's a time for us to prepare our hearts for the miracle of Jesus' resurrection. Believers typically choose to give up something they enjoy or abstain from doing specific things in remembrance of the sacrifice Christ made for humanity and His desert fast.
- * March 8--Daylight Savings Time -Don't forget to "Spring Forward" your clock 1 hour on Sunday!
- * March 17--St. Patrick's Day--Celebrates the national apostle of Ireland, who used the 3 leaf clover to teach people about the Trinity.

James Van Der Beek is a late actor that recently passed away from cancer. I was very touched by one of his last interviews.

LADIES BIBLE STUDY- Bonnie Vidal

What we are learning: Our study is based upon God's heavenly pattern described at Hebrews 8:5. God's Word has always provided descriptions or blueprints of each pattern—which ALWAYS reflect an evolving picture of Christ. Our current pattern study is called **The Body of Christ**, and it is the writer to the Hebrews and Apostle Peter who explain that the followers of Christ are being built into The House of God.

Hebrews Chapter 3 compares God's House under the administration of two overseers—Moses and Christ. God gave Moses The Law for the Children of Israel and instructions for building God's House (the tabernacle). However, Moses was only **God's servant**, so this tabernacle was only a picture of things to come. In contrast, **Christ as God's Son** is the true administer over God's House. The writer to the Hebrews states that all believers in Christ are now God's House.

1 Peter Chapter 2 explains how we, through Christ, are being built into a *spiritual house of God*, becoming a holy priesthood—but not priests who offer the blood of bulls, but instead, we are to offer spiritual sacrifices, like giving up the passions of the flesh that take us far from God. The Body of Christ is people from ALL nations becoming ONE people, by following Christ and serving One God. "Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people..." 1 Peter 2:10. Hallelujah! Selah.
