LADIES BIBLE STUDY- Bonnye Vidal



What we are learning: Our study is based upon God's heavenly pattern described at <u>Hebrews 8:5</u>. God's Word has always provided descriptions or blueprints of each pattern—which ALWAYS reflect an evolving picture of Christ.

Currently, we're studying a mystery story. Throughout a novel, the writer intermingles clues within the storyline that will support an unexpected surprise ending. In the same way, God intermingled clues within the storyline of the Old Testament to support the unexpected revelation that Gentiles are heirs together with Israel to form One Body In Christ Jesus, see Ephesians 3:6. Apostle Paul uses the word 'mystery' fourteen times in his epistles to reveal the mystery of what God has done through His Son Jesus Christ. We are following the clues that Paul has revealed to help us better understand these revelations—What is The Body of Christ? and How does this affects us?

Do you love a good mystery story? There is much to learn about how this pattern affects our current lives. We'll be studying it for several months, weaving old and new testaments together. Ladies, this is the perfect time to hop on board. Selah.

In present day English, if you say that a person is someone "after your own heart," it means that that person likes or appreciates something that you also like or appreciate very much. For instance, say you like Southern Gospel music and you find someone else does... you say, "that's a person after my own heart."

The expression originally referred to David, as described in Samuel's rebuke of Saul in 1 Samuel 13:14: "But now thy kingdom shall not continue: the Lord hath sought Him a man after His own heart and the Lord hath commanded him to be captain over his people..."
