I Never Knew That Was in the Bible... Manna From Heaven

Manna was the food miraculously provided by God for the Israelites in the wilderness. It had the appearance of coriander seed and tasted like honey (Exodus 16:31). The word "manna" means "what is it?" - the question the Israelites posed when they saw the substance for the first time. It is known as "bread from heaven" (John 16:31) It is that phrase that is sometimes used in contemporary English to refer to a **much-needed --- but unexpected gift.**
