

Peace Valley Nature Center

Nestled in the heart of historic Bucks County at the northeastern end of Peace Valley Park, the Nature Center features a **Visitor Center, bird blind, restrooms, and 14 miles of nature trails** winding through diverse habitats rich with native plants and wildlife.



Peace Valley Nature Center and Park together are recognized as an **Important Bird Area (IBA)**, with more than **250 species of birds** documented here. The bird blind, located near the Visitor Center, offers excellent opportunities for year-round birdwatching.

We offer **seasonal educational programs** for all ages and welcome community service groups and environmental organizations to participate in projects that benefit the preserve.

Inside the Visitor Center, you'll find interpretive **displays**, a place to **relax with coffee** while enjoying views of **Lake Galena**, and the **Sunflower Shop**, featuring a wide variety of nature-inspired gifts.

Trail Rules

- No pets or bikes are permitted on unpaved Nature Center trails.
- Leashed pets and bikes are welcome on the paved Bike & Hike Trail around Lake Galena.
- Special Wildlife Areas are off-limits to people and pets to protect sensitive habitats.







MOST POPULAR LOOP WALKS

- MINI LOOP** (10 - 20 minutes) - from Solar Building - stop at "Polly Pond" - go through woods - past small ponds & butterfly field
- EVERGREEN TRAIL** (20 - 30 minutes) - from parking lot to Persimmon Pond - around Pooh Tree Loop - return by Habitat Trail
- LAKE WALK** (30 - 40 minutes) - out to edge of Lake Galena - up Deer Path to Sunrise Trek - return by Mini Loop through woods
- UPPER WOODS TRAIL** (30 - 40 min) - across Chapman Road bridge - turn left - follow to Upper Woods Loop
return by Morning Bird Walk
