FLEDGLING FLOCK

Programs for Children ages 3-5 with a caregiver.

Each day includes a book, activity, and hike.

Session 1 & 6: Doodlebugs

With inspiration from the natural world, enjoy some creative fun using natural materials to create various types of art.

Session 2 & 7: Mud Pies

Experiment with soil, make mud, jump in a mud puddle, create mud pies and more. Be prepared for a muddy good time!

Session 3 & 8: Where's Your Home? Nests, Tunnels & Holes

Do you live in a house? What is it made of? What do you think animals do for a home? Let's go discover where the animals live.

Session 4 & 9: Wings & Things

Gather our bug boxes, hand lenses and off we go to inspect and discover where the critters are and what they're up to.

Session 5: Woods, Rocks, & Water

Let's play with wood, rocks, and water to learn why these materials are important (and fun) and understand how animals use them.

EXPLORERS & RANGERS

Each day brings new adventures and experiences. Campers will be able to choose from a variety of activities throughout the day.
