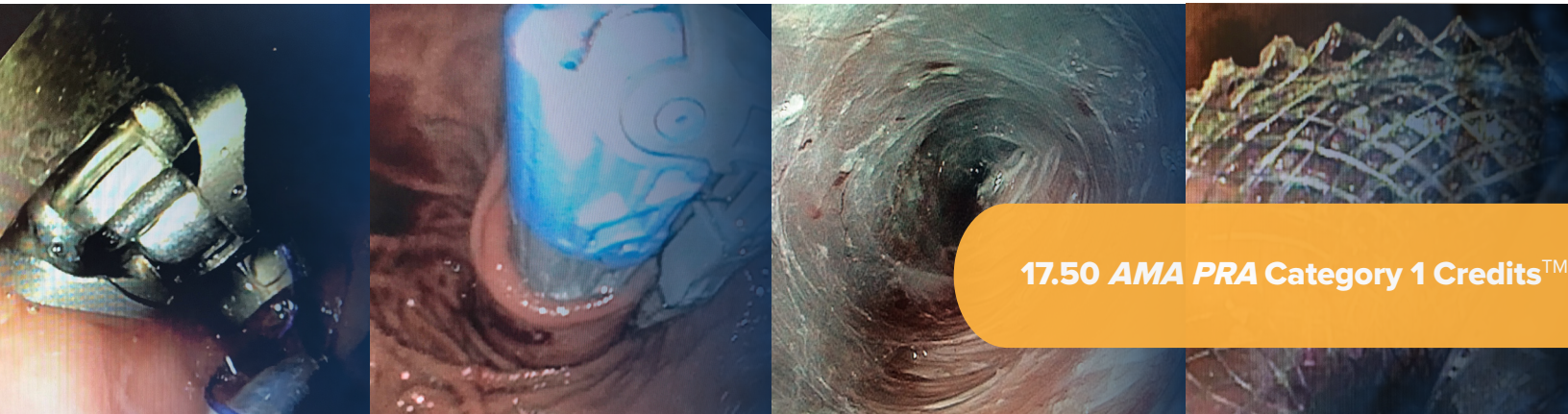

- Hands-on training on 9 advanced endoscopy stations, and taught by expert faculty

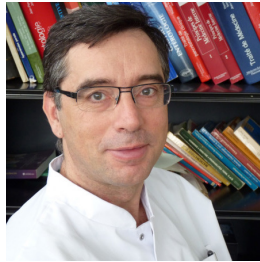
