Day 1: Wednesday, July 29, 2026 Overnight Flight From cosmopolitan London to romantic Paris, see the best of the world's most captivating cities. To help make the most of your getaway, unpack just once in each city. Enjoy a leisurely-paced journey with plenty of time for independent exploration.

Day 2: Thursday, July 30, 2026 London, England Arrive in London, England's dynamic capital. With no planned activities through the afternoon, take the time to explore on your own. This evening, gather with your fellow travelers for a taste of traditional pub fare - where else but at a London pub! (D)

Day 3: Friday, July 31, 2026 London Start your morning with a local in London. Kick it off with a three-hour walking tour of Westminster, taking in exterior views of Big Ben, the Houses of Parliament, Westminster Abbey, and Buckingham Palace. Day 4: Saturday, August 1, 2026 London After a hearty breakfast, head over to the South Bank to take a "flight" on the iconic London Eye.* Have cameras at the ready for this unforgettable journey with 360-degree panoramic views of London. This afternoon is yours to further explore independently, or you may wish to join the optional tour to Kensington Palace** for a self-guided visit and lunch. (B)

Day 5: Sunday, August 2, 2026 London - Paris, France *Allons-y!* Today, you're off to Paris! Hop aboard the Eurostar high-speed train to get there in just two hours. A sophisticated metropolis of style and culture, Paris' bustling city streets are filled with colorful history, fascinating museums, renowned monuments and grand theatres. The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day

is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

The walking tour in London will be a little over 3 hours and requires standing up to 20 minutes at various sites.

Some of the most unique sightseeing can mean accessing locations that restrict motor coaches, especially in the historic areas of Paris, such as Montmartre and Versailles, which require the ability to walk up and down hills and on cobblestoned streets and stairs.

***If you choose to participate in the Choice on Tour to Montmartre, please note that you will need to walk 1.2 miles on cobblestones and feel comfortable standing while riding the Parisian subway.

If you require a walker or wheelchair, or have difficulty walking, you may not be able to access some of the areas on this tour and may want to consider an alternate tour with us. Our Client Care Agents can provide additional information or assistance to help you determine the perfect trip for you.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.



Day 9: Paris - Amsterdam, Netherlands

Board a high-speed train* and take off for Amsterdam, the thriving 800-year-old capital of Holland. After some time to settle in, meet up with a local guide to get acquainted with the Jordaan District of Amsterdam. Explore this charming neighborhood and learn of its rich multicultural roots during a walking food tour where you'll taste traditional Dutch fare as you walk along the canals and historic homes between stops. *Today dinner will be included.*

Day 10: Amsterdam

Stroll through the city with a local expert. Get acquainted with the cozy lanes and quintessential Dutch houses as you wander along the canals that lead to Amsterdam's Museum District. The overall activity level of this extension is a level 3. This means walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal for you. You can navigate hills and uneven ground, climb into various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.), and could possibly anticipate changes in elevation. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable as is climbing 3 flights of stairs. You can handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. You can expect some longer days balanced with free time. This level is not a fit for travelers that require mobility assistance devices.

During this extension, you can expect to have a **hosted** experience or two, with a local representative revealing more of what this destination has to offer. Enjoy a mix of independent exploration and guided sightseeing and experiences.

We reserve the right to cancel this extension if a minimum of 4 travelers is not met to operate.

We will use public transportation during the walking tour of Amsterdam.

**The Anne Frank House is one of the most popular sites in Amsterdam. Tickets are in high demand and are difficult to obtain on the day or close to the day of visit. If you are interested, we recommend that you purchase tickets online in advance through the museum's official website. Tickets should be purchased for the afternoon on your second day in Amsterdam or any time during your third day in Amsterdam. To plan your visit in advance, on the second day in Amsterdam your free time starts after 2:00 p.m., and the third day is free for own explorations.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

Triple rooms are not available. Upon request, triple accommodations can be confirmed in a double and a single room, or a cot may be requested at an additional cost.

*Porterage is not available in Paris and Amsterdam train stations. You'll be responsible for handling your own luggage from the vehicle drop-off point to the train in Paris and in Amsterdam from the train to the vehicle that will transfer you to the hotel.
