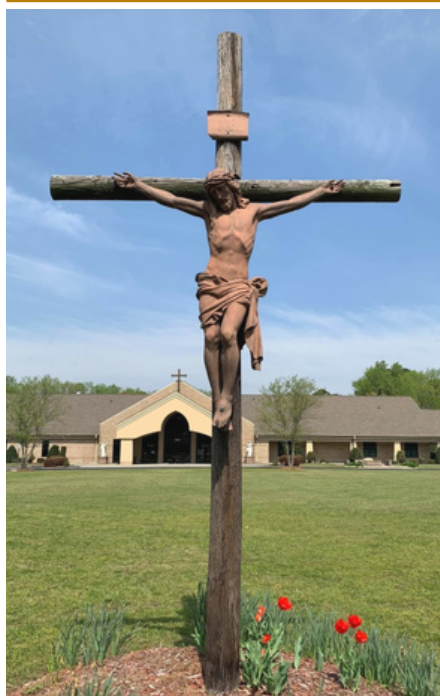

ANOINTING THE SICK: Please call the parish office if you or a member of your family needs the Sacrament of Anointing.

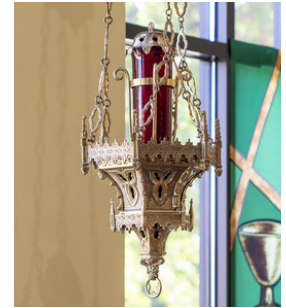
HOMEBOUND/SHUT-INS: If there is anyone who cannot come to Mass because of illness or age, we ask you to please call the parish office.

Parish Financial Report

St Gabriel Fiscal Year July 2025 – June 2026 Financial Report

Dear Parishioners,

St. Gabriel is blessed with generous support from our parishioners and friends. Our Parish community continues to support our Church, and we are happy to report that our Offertory and Donations exceeded our expectations.

Our total Income for this fiscal year was: \$738,433

Our total fiscal year expenses were: \$684,511, with a surplus of \$53,922

Our banking account status for the fiscal year was:

Building Fund: \$81,310

General Savings: \$114,630

Checking: \$88,792

Thank you for your generosity. While the final year-end results reflect a small operating surplus, the costs associated with maintaining our aging facilities are an ongoing concern. We expect rising costs in utilities, supplies, and maintenance will continue to be a challenge for the next fiscal year.

We will continue to manage expenses to maintain a surplus for the next fiscal year to help meet any unexpected expenses or repairs. We are thankful for the generosity of our Parishioners.

St. Gabriel currently does not have any loans with the Diocese.

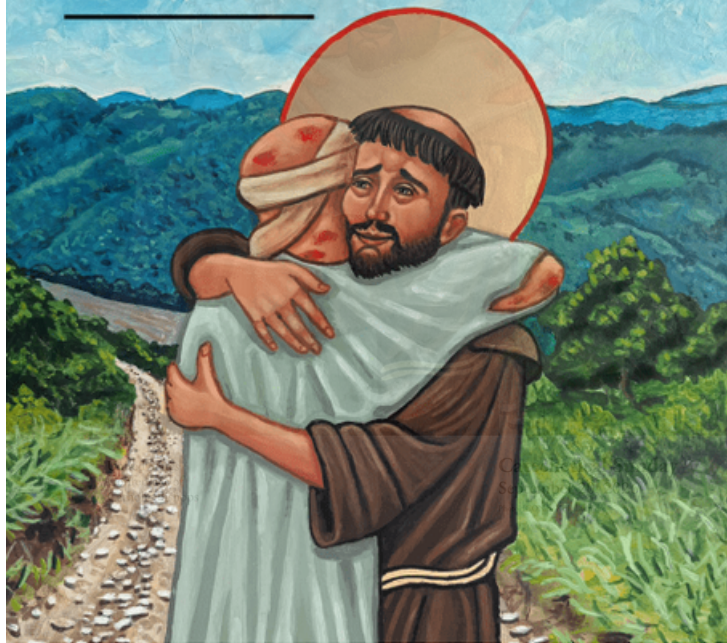
