Harris County ESD 16 Announces Election Results

Proposition A, Increasing the Tax Rate Cap

(Klein, TX. May 5, 2025) Harris County Emergency Services District 16, Klein Fire Department ("HCESD 16" or "KFD") would like to announce the results of the recent election held on May 3, 2025.

Voters in the HCESD 16 area have rejected a proposal by the Emergency Services District to increase the tax rate cap, according to unofficial election results released at 8:47 p.m. on Saturday, May 3, 2025.

The proposal, which aimed to increase the rate from \$0.05, where it was set in 2010, to \$0.10, the maximum allowed in the State of Texas, was meant to allow the District to respond more adequately to the dramatically increased population and commercial business growth in the Klein area, where emergency calls have increased 300-fold. The proposition was defeated by a margin of 3 votes.

"While we are disappointed in the outcome, we respect the voters' decision. We will continue to explore alternative funding options to ensure the safety and well-being of our community," said Fire Chief Jason Catrambone.

Lance Wilson, ESD 16 Board of Commissioners President added, "We appreciate the community's engagement in this important decision. We will now reassess our budget and prioritize our resources accordingly."
