Greetings, friends. This weekend the universal Church celebrates Divine Mercy Sunday, inspired by the mystical visions of Jesus as the Divine Mercy to St. Faustina Kowalska almost 100 years ago in Poland. Pope St. John Paul II selected the second Sunday of Easter as Divine Mercy Sunday, pairing it as closely as possible with the ultimate manifestation of God's Divine Mercy for us – his Son Jesus' passion, death and resurrection for our salvation. The messages received by St. Faustina had much to do with God's unfathomable mercy for us, depicted often as the 'ocean' of His mercy. The graces which we receive through Jesus as the Divine Mercy have no limits on their depth. No matter our past errors and mistakes, His Mercy is here for all of us!

In our readings this weekend, we see the very real power of the Holy Spirit manifested in the lives of the first Christians. In Acts, we hear about the first experiences of life among believers as a faith community. "All who believed were together and had all things in common;

they would sell their property and possessions and divide them among all according to each one's needs. They ate their meals with exaltation and sincerity of heart, praising God and enjoying favor with all the people." (Acts 2:44–47). I'd like to suggest that those of us who were able to attend the services of our Triduum, or watch them over live streaming, experienced some of that great joy and holiness that those first Christians felt. In our second reading, St. Peter explains the source of that joy: "God the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who in his great *mercy*, gave us a new birth to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead..." (1 Peter 1:3). We rejoice with an "indescribable joy" as we attain the goal of our faith – salvation!

In our gospel from John, he provides us with an account of what transpired on that first Sunday of Jesus' resurrection – when the apostles hid behind locked doors for fear of their lives. Jesus appears to them, prayed over them His peace, and breathed on them the Holy Spirit, enabling them on their mission to be sent forth and preach the Good News everywhere. Here we also encounter Thomas, recalled often as the 'doubter'. He expresses a doubt that crosses our minds from time to time – is Jesus as Messiah for real? As Fr. Bert pointed out in a homily over the

Triduum: nobody dies for a lie. The martyrdom of the apostles and the tens of millions who have died for their faith since the time of Christ provide testimony to the Truth: Jesus is Messiah! He remains present to us in the Eucharist we receive today. Despite our sinfulness and shortcomings, He continues to work miracles in our lives and hearts every day. He has indeed prepared a place for each of us in Eternity. That is Divine Mercy!

Lord Jesus, help us to soften our hardened hearts and repent of our worldly ways, accept the great Mercy you offer us, and embrace and return the great love you have for us to You and to each other!

Happy and glorious Divine Mercy Sunday!

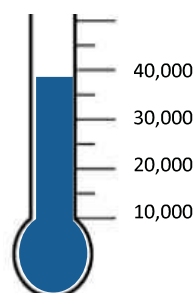

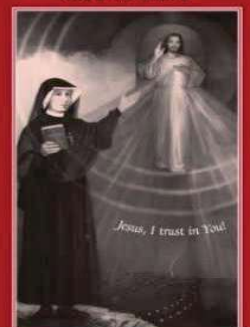
In preparation for the Feast of The Divine Mercy, the Lord asked Sister Faustina to make a **novena of prayer from Good Friday to the following Saturday.** These nine days of prayer (the word ‘novena’ means nine) before the Feast of Mercy are like the nine days of prayer in the upper room before the day of Pentecost: (see Acts 1:14).

For each of the nine days, our Lord gave Sister Faustina a different intention: all mankind; especially sinners; the souls of priests and religious; all devout and faithful souls; those who do not believe in Him and those who do not yet know Him; the souls of the separated brethren; the meek and humble souls and the souls of the little children; the souls who especially venerate and glorify His mercy; the souls detained in purgatory; souls who have become lukewarm.

Pamphlets can be found at the church entrances. Everyone is encouraged to pray this privately until Divine Mercy Sunday (April 12).

TRIDUUM SERVICES

God's graces were abundant at this year's Triduum services. Sixteen parishioners received Sacraments of Initiation at the Vigil Mass, and the presence of the Holy Spirit was undeniable. May God continue to pour his blessings out upon our parish, and upon these sixteen families.





Saudações, amigos. Neste fim de semana, a Igreja universal celebra o Domingo da Divina Misericórdia, inspirada nas visões místicas de Jesus — como a Divina Misericórdia — concedidas a Santa Faustina Kowalska, há quase 100 anos, na Polônia. O Papa São João Paulo II escolheu o segundo domingo da Páscoa como o Domingo da Divina Misericórdia, vinculando-o o mais estreitamente possível à manifestação suprema da Divina Misericórdia de Deus para conosco: a paixão, morte e ressurreição de seu Filho, Jesus, para a nossa salvação. As mensagens recebidas por Santa Faustina diziam respeito, em grande medida, à insondável misericórdia de Deus para conosco — frequentemente descrita como o "oceano" de Sua misericórdia. As graças que recebemos por meio de Jesus, a Divina Misericórdia, não têm limites em sua profundidade. Independentemente de nossos erros e equívocos do passado, a Sua Misericórdia está aqui para todos nós!

Em nossas leituras deste fim de semana, vemos o poder muito real do Espírito Santo manifestado nas vidas dos primeiros cristãos. Nos Atos dos Apóstolos, ouvimos falar das primeiras experiências de vida entre os fiéis como uma comunidade de fé. “Todos os que creram estavam unidos e tinham tudo em comum; vendiam suas propriedades e bens e os repartiam entre todos, conforme a necessidade de cada um. Tomavam suas refeições com exultação e sinceridade de coração, louvando a Deus e gozando da simpatia de todo o povo.” (Atos 2:44–47). Gostaria de sugerir que aqueles de nós que puderam participar das celebrações do nosso Tríduo, ou assisti-las por transmissão ao vivo, experimentaram um pouco daquela grande alegria e santidade que aqueles primeiros cristãos sentiram. Em nossa segunda leitura, São Pedro explica a fonte dessa alegria: “Deus, o Pai de nosso Senhor Jesus Cristo, que, em sua grande misericórdia, nos fez renascer para uma esperança viva, pela ressurreição de Jesus Cristo dentre os mortos...” (1 Pedro 1:3). Alegremo-nos com uma “alegria indescritível” ao alcançarmos a meta da nossa fé: a salvação!

Uma mensagem do nosso clero

Em nosso Evangelho de João, ele nos apresenta um relato do que aconteceu naquele primeiro domingo da ressurreição de Jesus — quando os apóstolos se esconderam atrás de portas trancadas, temendo por suas vidas. Jesus lhes aparece, invoca sobre eles a Sua paz e sopra sobre eles o Espírito Santo, capacitando-os para a missão de serem enviados e pregarem a Boa Nova por toda parte. Aqui também encontramos Tomé, frequentemente lembrado como o "duvidoso". Ele expressa uma dúvida que, de tempos em tempos, nos passa pela mente: será que Jesus, como Messias, é real? Como observou o Pe. Bert em uma homilia durante o Tríduo: ninguém morre por uma mentira. O martírio dos apóstolos e das dezenas de milhões de pessoas que morreram por sua fé desde os tempos de Cristo dão testemunho da Verdade: Jesus é o Messias! Ele permanece presente entre nós na Eucaristia que hoje recebemos. Apesar de nossa condição pecadora e de nossas imperfeições, Ele continua a realizar milagres em nossas vidas e em nossos corações, todos os dias. Ele, de fato, preparou um lugar para cada um de nós na Eternidade. Isso é a Divina Misericórdia!

Senhor Jesus, ajuda-nos a abrandar nossos corações endurecidos e a nos arrepender de nossos caminhos mundanos, a aceitar a grande Misericórdia que nos ofereces, e a acolher e retribuir o grande amor que tens por nós — a Ti e uns aos outros!
