Greetings, friends. If you're like me, you've probably had 'Aha' moments, experiences where you connect the dots and finally understand things presented to you that were right before your eyes, but you didn't / couldn't comprehend it. Sometimes this happens even in our spiritual lives. As clergy, you may think that your priests and deacons have all things about our faith pretty much locked up and completely understood. I can assure you – any good and holy clergy that you may know are on really on their own faith journeys as well. Just recently I had another of my own 'revelations' of sorts. I've long believed that the Eucharist is the real material presence of Jesus in the consecrated host. It was just recently, however, that I realized that when I behold the host elevated by the priest at consecration, or look at it as I

prepare to receive Him in Communion, that I am looking directly at the face of Jesus. He just happens to be hidden by the 'accidents' of the Eucharist – what we think of as the adjectives that describe the consecrated host: it looks like unleavened bread, tastes like it, feels like it, and breaks like it. But those adjectives belie the fact that that altar bread has been changed, '*transubstantiated*' into the Body and Blood of Christ. Baptism and ordination through Holy Orders also produce a profound change not perceptible to the eyes. Baptism forever changes a person, making them part of Christ's Body, the Church. By ordination, Fr. Bert, Dcn Jared and I haven't changed our physical appearances, but we are assuredly changed into new beings. We are never the same again.

In our gospel reading, we have the beautiful story of the two disciples on the Road to Emmaus – about 19 miles west of Jerusalem. Jesus is present with them on their journey, but they don't recognize Him. Similar to our own liturgy, those disciples receive a *Liturgy of the Word*, as Jesus unpacks everything in the scriptures about Him, and how all of the OT prophesies about Him are fulfilled – particularly His death and resurrection. They invite Jesus in to stay with them. Around the table, they receive a *Liturgy of the Eucharist*. Jesus takes bread, says the blessing, breaks it and shares it with them. And with that, they connect the dots; their hearts burn within them, and their eyes are opened. They are never the same again.

Those disciples encountered Jesus in the Eucharist – the Breaking of the Bread. It opened their eyes. It begs the question – if we can fail to perceive Jesus at work in every event in our own lives, imagine how much we could be missing! What veils are we walking around with over our own eyes? It's in the Sacraments, particularly the Eucharist, where we encounter the Real presence of Jesus. As we behold Him, recognize also that He is looking directly at us! Lord Jesus, help us to remove the veils that block us from seeing you, and experiencing your real

presence in our hearts. Open our eyes, and in doing so, transform our hearts to be living and breathing members of Your Body here on earth.

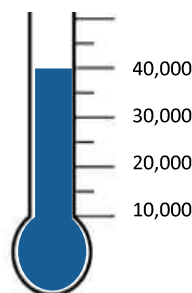

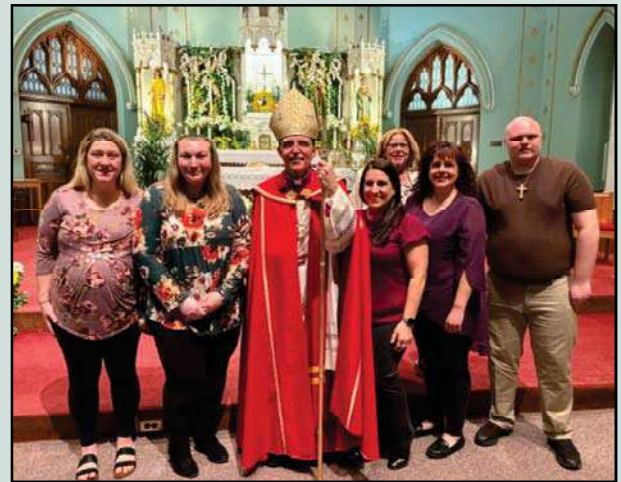


