Greetings brothers and sisters.

Over the past few months, due to feedback from parishioners and staff, we've had concerns that mold may be present in the ground floor of the Parish Center (PC). We recently engaged with a professional who is able to test for this kind of concern. He was able to confirm that there is mold present in the two boiler rooms and throughout the ground floor of the PC. This has prompted a remediation effort of the mold, an assessment for what we need to do to mitigate it going forward, as well as complete a general top-to-bottom cleaning of the facility. We estimate the total project will cost **around \$90,000.**

Please Note: Due to the scope of the work, there will be limited access to the Parish Center for the remainder of August, and it will be closed through September. No one will be permitted into the ground floor of the Parish Center for any reason. Staff will primarily be working remotely (with some exceptions) until the work is finished.

The scope of what we are planning to do includes:

- a) Mold remediation cleaning of the affected areas by a licensed vendor. (Same company that did the Rectory in recent years. They did a great job!!)
- b) Pulling up old, dingy carpets on the ground floor that harbor mold and dampness.
- c) Asbestos abatement, where necessary, resulting from carpet removal.
- d) Replacement / repair of access points where moisture can enter the building.
- e) Installation of 4 high-capacity dehumidifiers.
- f) Installation of new flooring on the ground floor gathering spaces.
- g) Selected landscaping outside the building to keep rainwater away from outside boiler room doors.
- h) Cleaning of rain gutters and redirection of rainwater away from the foundation walls
- i) Extensive room cleaning – walls, ceilings, furniture, windows, floors, and carpet extraction - of all rooms on all of the upper floors, and removal of obsolete supplies and materials that are no longer of any value to the parish.

This scope is comprehensive, as we believe it has not been done in many years. **All of these efforts are intended to make our campus spaces safe, comfortable, and attractive for the many ministries provided by our incredible parish.**

We are estimating the costs to be in the neighborhood of **approximately \$90,000.00**, for which we have included line itemization on Page 2 of the bulletin. We have proposals to complete some of these tasks, and are in the process of getting additional proposals for the remaining tasks.

Coming on the heels of replacing the boilers last year, this project is a heavy lift for our parish. So, we are starting fundraising efforts now and gratefully accept donations earmarked for this project. If you send in a check, please note **"MOLD"** in the memo line of your check. Or feel free to use this QR code to create a one-time donation or recurring donation.

OCIA Program at St. Michael's:

Is the Holy Spirit calling you to be Catholic?

If you were never baptized, or if you were baptized by a non-Catholic minister, we invite you to learn more about Catholicism by registering for the 2026-2027 session of OCIA at St. Michael Parish. Our OCIA program meets on Monday evenings, beginning in late September and ending at the Easter Vigil on March 27, 2027.

Throughout the OCIA process, participants are invited into deep study and reflection on the teachings of the Church. Guided by a team of priests, deacons, and lay people, we explore Scripture, the Sacraments, Church history, and moral teachings. These sessions are instructional, but always allow time for open conversations—for questions, doubts, and heartfelt dialogue, where the learning is as much about growing in understanding as it is about growing in faith.

At the end of the instructional year, the Catechumens will receive the Sacraments of Initiation on Holy Saturday. For them, this is the moment they will encounter the Body and Blood of Christ for the first time. But it is equally a monumental moment for us—the St. Michael's community—as we welcome these new members into the family of believers. It is a profound reminder that the Church is not just a place, but a living, breathing community of faith, united in love and purpose.

Full, Conscious, and Active Participation (Part 3 of 3): Two Practices Worth Understanding

The Sign of Peace: More Than a Greeting

It's easy to treat the Sign of Peace as a friendly social pause — a chance to shake hands with our neighbors. But as one religious sister explained in a catechetical video from Spain, the rite is not a greeting; it is a preparation to approach Communion worthily, rooted in Christ's words in Matthew's Gospel about reconciling with one's brother before offering a gift at the altar. The gesture is ancient — so much so that the Irish word for "kiss," póg, comes from the Latin pax, peace.

Peace from the Altar

Because it comes after the Consecration, the peace we exchange is not something we generate among ourselves; it is, first, a blessing flowing from Christ present on the altar — his own words, "My peace I give unto you" (John 14:27). The General Instruction of the Roman Missal asks that it be offered only to those nearest us, and in a sober manner, preserving the reverent hush that leads into Communion. A 2014 instruction from the Congregation for Divine Worship, confirmed by Pope Francis, discouraged wandering from one's pew, "peace songs," and using the moment for congratulations or condolences — precisely because these distract from its true purpose: restoring peace and unity before we receive the Eucharist.

An Act of Reconciliation

The rite is meant to do real spiritual work, not simply mark a transition in the Mass. It is an invitation to examine, however briefly, whether any unforgiveness or division lingers in our hearts, and to let Christ's peace touch those fractured places before we approach the altar. In that sense, the handshake or nod we exchange with the people nearest us is meant to be a small, embodied echo of the reconciliation Christ himself accomplishes in the Eucharist.

Taken together with what we discussed last week, this points to the same underlying truth: the liturgy is a gift handed on to us, not ours to reshape by preference. Our task is to enter fully into the rite already given — offering our whole selves, in union with Christ at the altar.

Saudações, irmãos e irmãs.

Nos últimos meses, devido a relatos de paroquianos e da equipe, surgiu a preocupação de que poderia haver mofo no andar térreo do Centro Paroquial (CP). Recentemente, contratamos um profissional qualificado para realizar testes e verificar essa questão. Ele confirmou a presença de mofo nas duas salas das caldeiras e em todo o andar térreo do CP. Isso motivou a necessidade de um trabalho de remoção do mofo, uma avaliação das medidas de mitigação para o futuro e uma limpeza geral completa de toda a instalação. **Estimamos que o custo total do projeto será de cerca de US\$ 90.000.**

Atenção: Devido à extensão do trabalho, o acesso ao Centro Paroquial será limitado durante o restante de agosto, e o local permanecerá fechado durante todo o mês de setembro. Ninguém terá permissão para entrar no andar térreo do Centro Paroquial, sob qualquer pretexto. A equipe trabalhará principalmente de forma remota (com algumas exceções) até a conclusão das obras.

O escopo do trabalho planejado inclui:

- a) Limpeza e remoção de mofo nas áreas afetadas, realizada por uma empresa especializada e licenciada. (A mesma empresa que trabalhou na Casa Paroquial recentemente; eles fizeram um excelente trabalho!)
- b) Retirada dos carpetes antigos e desgastados do andar térreo, que acumulam mofo e umidade.
- c) Remoção de amianto, onde necessário, decorrente da retirada dos carpetes.
- d) Substituição ou reparo de pontos de acesso por onde a umidade pode entrar no edifício.
- e) Instalação de 4 desumidificadores de alta capacidade.
- f) Instalação de novo piso nas áreas de convivência do andar térreo.
- g) Paisagismo específico na área externa para afastar a água da chuva das portas externas das salas das caldeiras.
- h) Limpeza de calhas e redirecionamento da água da chuva para longe das paredes da fundação.
- i) Limpeza profunda de todos os ambientes — paredes, tetos, móveis, janelas, pisos e higienização de carpetes — nos andares superiores, além do descarte de materiais e suprimentos obsoletos que não têm mais utilidade para a paróquia.

Este escopo é abrangente, pois acreditamos que esse tipo de manutenção não é realizado há muitos anos. **Todos esses esforços visam tornar as instalações do nosso campus seguras, confortáveis e acolhedoras para os diversos ministérios realizados pela nossa incrível paróquia.**

Estimamos que os custos fiquem em torno de **US\$ 90.000,00**; o detalhamento dessas despesas consta na página 2 do boletim paroquial. Já temos propostas para a execução de algumas dessas tarefas e estamos buscando orçamentos adicionais para as demais.

Dando continuidade à substituição das caldeiras realizada no ano passado, este projeto representa um grande desafio financeiro para a nossa paróquia. Por isso, estamos iniciando uma campanha de arrecadação e aceitamos com gratidão doações destinadas especificamente a este projeto. 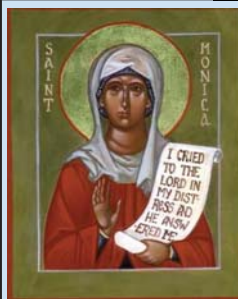

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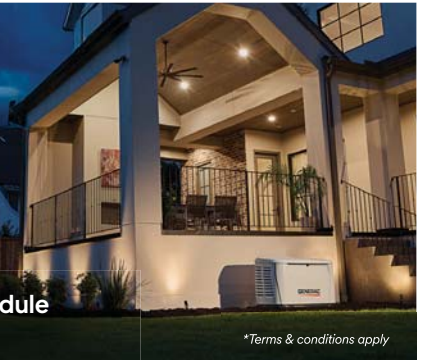
