On this 11th Sunday in Ordinary Time, our readings combine into one overarching theme, specifically chosen in our Lectionary to follow from our Solemnity of Corpus Christi – the Most Holy Body and Blood, from last weekend. In our readings, we hear that God chooses a people, He saves them freely and sends them on mission. Let's dive into this a bit.

In our first reading from Exodus, the Israelites arrive at Mount Sinai, where God speaks to Moses. God reminds the Israelites of how He freely delivered them from slavery in Egypt and declares that if they obey His commands and keep His covenant, they will be a treasured possession and a kingdom of priests. He gives them a 'mission' - to be a priestly nation, mediating His presence to the world. The Church sees herself as the fulfillment of this priestly people (cf. CCC 781; 1 Peter 2:9).

A Message from Our Clergy

Deacon Chuck

In our second reading from Romans, God showed His love for humanity by sending Jesus Christ to die for our sins while we were still sinners. Through Jesus' sacrifice, we can be reconciled with God and receive the gift of eternal life. Our salvation is God's work, not ours. Christ died for us when we were still sinners, showing that God's love is unconditional, a gift freely offered through Jesus.

In our gospel from Matthew, Jesus sends the twelve apostles to proclaim the kingdom of heaven. The signs of the kingdom's presence consist of the work that Jesus has already been doing: the sick are cured, lepers are cleansed, demons are driven out, and the dead are raised to life. The disciples are sent to continue doing the work that Jesus has begun.

Why do these readings follow from the feast of Corpus Christi last weekend? Corpus Christi celebrates the 'gift' of Christ's Body and Blood — the source and summit of the Church's life. Then, on this very next weekend, we hear Christ's command as mission:

Go! Proclaim the Kingdom. Heal the sick. Raise the dead.; We can't be sent on mission without being fed. The Eucharist and Apostolic mission are inseparable. What a beautiful message is received in this sequence. Eucharist – it's the key to fulfilling our personal missions that God has for each of us, and our living a full Christian life!

VIDEO SERIES FOR CATHOLIC MEN

Brazilian & Portuguese Community Information

Neste 11º Domingo do Tempo Comum, nossas leituras convergem para um tema central, escolhido especificamente em nosso Lecionário para dar continuidade à Solenidade de Corpus Christi — o Santíssimo Corpo e Sangue de Cristo — celebrada no fim de semana passado. Nas leituras, ouvimos que Deus escolhe um povo, salva-o gratuitamente e o envia em missão. Vamos nos aprofundar um pouco nisso.

Em nossa primeira leitura, extraída do livro do Êxodo, os israelitas chegam ao Monte Sinai, onde Deus fala a Moisés. Deus recorda aos israelitas como os libertou gratuitamente da escravidão no Egito e declara que, se obedecerem aos Seus mandamentos e guardarem a Sua aliança, serão uma propriedade preciosa e um reino de sacerdotes. Ele lhes confia uma "missão": ser uma nação sacerdotal, mediando a Sua presença para o mundo. A Igreja vê a si mesma como a realização desse povo sacerdotal (cf. CIC 781; 1 Pedro 2,9).

Uma Mensagem do Nosso Clero

Deacon Chuck

Em nossa segunda leitura, extraída da Carta aos Romanos, Deus demonstrou Seu amor pela humanidade ao enviar Jesus Cristo para morrer por nossos pecados enquanto ainda éramos pecadores. Por meio do sacrifício de Jesus, podemos ser reconciliados com Deus e receber o dom da vida eterna. Nossa salvação é obra de Deus, não nossa. Cristo morreu por nós quando ainda éramos pecadores, mostrando que o amor de Deus é incondicional — um dom oferecido gratuitamente por meio de Jesus.

No nosso Evangelho segundo Mateus, Jesus envia os doze apóstolos para proclamar o Reino dos Céus. Os sinais da presença do Reino consistem nas obras que Jesus já vinha realizando: os doentes são curados, os leprosos são purificados, os demônios são expulsos e os mortos são ressuscitados. Os discípulos são enviados para dar continuidade à obra que Jesus iniciou.

Por que estas leituras vêm na sequência da festa de Corpus Christi, celebrada no fim de semana passado? Corpus Christi celebra o "dom" do Corpo e do Sangue de Cristo — fonte e ápice da vida da Igreja. Logo no fim de semana seguinte, ouvimos a ordem de Cristo que constitui a nossa missão: "Ide! Proclamai o Reino. Curai os enfermos. Ressuscitai os mortos". Não podemos ser enviados em missão sem antes sermos alimentados. A Eucaristia e a missão apostólica são inseparáveis. Que bela mensagem recebemos nesta sequência. A Eucaristia é a chave para cumprirmos as missões pessoais que Deus tem para cada um de nós e para vivermos uma vida cristã plena!
