Greetings brothers and sisters. Happy Father's Day weekend to all the dads out there, especially first-timers who are stepping out embracing, or getting ready to embrace, all that fatherhood means! Our readings this weekend have much to do with courage, trust, and not being afraid. As Dcn Jared mentions from time to time, it costs something to be part of the body of Christ, and we have a few role models to talk about as we think about this.

First up is Jeremiah from our OT reading, one of the four major prophets (along with Isaiah, Ezekiel and Daniel). He was likely born around 650 BC. In our reading, he is having a crisis of faith. He has just been publicly humiliated, beaten and put in stocks (very uncomfortable physical restraints) by Pashhur, the priest and chief officer of the temple. He was tortured for speaking God's word at a time when the religious establishment didn't want to hear it. He had just finished delivering a prophecy in the temple courtyard that Jerusalem would be destroyed, the temple would fall, and the people would be taken into exile — unless they repented. The leadership refused to believe this, thinking that God would protect them regardless of their disobedience. Jeremiah's prophecy was fulfilled within 20 years of his warning. This pattern repeats throughout much of Jeremiah's ministry. Like the other prophets, he is imprisoned multiple times, threatened with death, mocked publicly, and abandoned by friends and family. All because he spoke God's truth when it was unpopular, costly and dangerous to do so. Jeremiah knew fear, and his suffering was real. His plea to God is what we hear in our responsorial psalm: Lord, in your great love, answer me! Then he remembers who God is, and that memory changes everything. Not because the danger goes away, but because God's presence becomes more real than the danger.

A Message from Our Clergy

Deacon Chuck

In our gospel from Matthew, Jesus is sharing with the apostles some bold challenges. Fear no one! Not even the sparrows fall to the ground without the Father's knowledge – and we are certainly worth more than many sparrows. This passage is part of Jesus' 'Missionary Discourse' in Matthew's gospel (thus – a continuation of the 'mission' theme of Matthew 9 from last weekend.) We're created in God's own image and can easily relate to Jesus' own suffering. We may hurt. We may feel alone. But God is a mighty champion, and He is with all of us. This message is for all of us, but especially our dads on this particular weekend.

Venerable Sr. Lucia, the last of the visionaries from Fatima, warned that the final battle between the Lord and the reign of Satan will be about marriage and the family. It's not hard to find the challenges within marriages and families today. We need our dads (and moms of course) to be the guardians of faith in our families – the 'domestic' church. Speak truth, and without fear, and with great trust in God! The church prays abundantly for your strength, guidance and protection. It's the reason we placed St. Joseph on our cover. Ask for his intercession. God the Father entrusted the upbringing up His Son to Joseph' paternal care. If we ask for his help, we can't go wrong!



Happy Father's Day. May God continue to bless all of you this special day and every day. We entrust each of you, and all of our families, to Jesus' everlasting love and care.

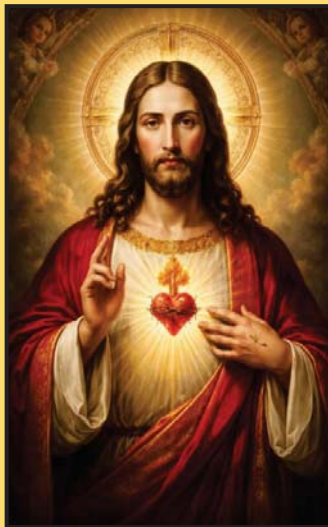

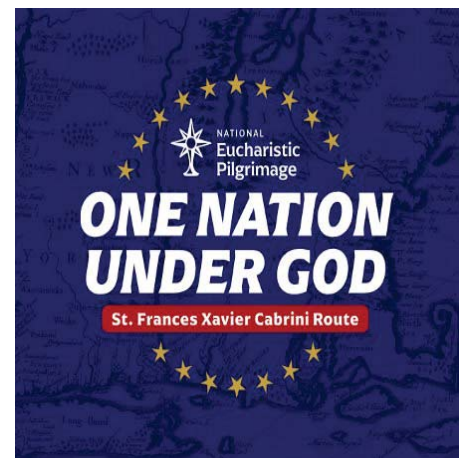
From St Michael's Join a Car Pool to the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage in the Archdiocese of Boston: Sunday, June 28, 2026

Brazilian & Portuguese Community Information

Saudações, irmãos e irmãs. Um feliz fim de semana de Dia dos Pais a todos os pais, especialmente àqueles que estão vivenciando a paternidade pela primeira vez e abraçando — ou se preparando para abraçar — tudo o que ela significa! As leituras deste fim de semana tratam muito de coragem, confiança e de não ter medo. Como o Diácono Jared menciona de tempos em tempos, fazer parte do Corpo de Cristo exige algo de nós, e temos alguns exemplos a destacar ao refletirmos sobre isso.

Começamos com Jeremias, personagem da nossa leitura do Antigo Testamento e um dos quatro grandes profetas (juntamente com Isaías, Ezequiel e Daniel). Ele provavelmente nasceu por volta de 650 a.C. Na leitura de hoje, ele atravessa uma crise de fé. Acabara de ser humilhado publicamente, espancado e colocado no tronco (um instrumento de imobilização física extremamente desconfortável) por Pasur, sacerdote e oficial-chefe do templo. Foi torturado por anunciar a palavra de Deus num momento em que a liderança religiosa não queria ouvi-la. Havia acabado de proferir, no pátio do templo, uma profecia segundo a qual Jerusalém seria destruída, o templo cairia e o povo seria levado ao exílio — a menos que se arrependesse. A liderança recusava-se a acreditar nisso, imaginando que Deus os protegeria independentemente de sua desobediência. A profecia de Jeremias cumpriu-se menos de vinte anos após o seu aviso. Esse padrão repete-se ao longo de grande parte do ministério de Jeremias. Assim como os outros profetas, ele é preso diversas vezes, ameaçado de morte, ridicularizado publicamente e abandonado por amigos e familiares. Tudo isso porque proclamou a verdade de Deus num momento em que fazê-lo era impopular, custoso e perigoso. Jeremias conheceu o medo, e o seu sofrimento foi real. O clamor que ele dirige a Deus é aquele que ouvimos no nosso salmo responsorial: "Senhor, no teu grande amor, responde-me!" Então, ele lembra quem Deus é, e essa lembrança muda tudo. Não porque o perigo desapareça, mas porque a presença de Deus se torna mais real do que o perigo.

Uma Mensagem do Nosso Clero

No Evangelho de Mateus, Jesus compartilha com os apóstolos alguns desafios ousados. Não temam ninguém! Nem mesmo os pardais caem no chão sem que o Pai o saiba — e nós, certamente, valem mais do que muitos pardais. Essa passagem faz parte do "Discurso Missionário" de Jesus no Evangelho de Mateus (sendo, portanto, uma continuação do tema da missão presente no capítulo 9, lido no fim de semana passado). Fomos criados à imagem de Deus e podemos facilmente nos identificar com o sofrimento do próprio Jesus. Podemos sentir dor. Podemos nos sentir sozinhos. Mas Deus é um poderoso defensor e está com todos nós, especialmente com os nossos pais neste fim de semana.

Venerável Irmã Lúcia, a última das videntes de Fátima, alertou que a batalha final entre o Senhor e o reino de Satanás se daria em torno do casamento e da família. Não é difícil perceber os desafios que os casamentos e as famílias enfrentam hoje. Precisamos que nossos pais (e as mães, é claro) sejam os guardiões da fé em nossas famílias — a Igreja doméstica. Falem a verdade, sem medo e com grande confiança em Deus! A Igreja reza intensamente por sua força, orientação e proteção. É por isso que colocamos São José em nossa capa. Peçam a sua intercessão. Deus Pai confiou a criação de Seu Filho aos cuidados paternos de José. Se pedirmos a ajuda dele, não há como errar!
