Sixth Sunday of Easter, 2026



This Sunday's readings invite us into a simple but demanding truth: **love is not a feeling—it is a way of living.**

In the Gospel, Jesus tells His disciples, "If you love me, you will keep my commandments." That can sound straightforward, even obvious. But if we sit with it, we realize how radical it is. Jesus is not asking for admiration. He is not asking for agreement. He is asking for transformation.

Love, in the Christian sense, is not passive. It moves. It acts. It chooses.

In the first reading from Acts, we see this love lived out. Philip goes to Samaria—a place many would have avoided—and proclaims Christ. The result is not just belief, but healing, liberation, and joy. Scripture tells us there was "great joy in that city." That joy did not come from comfort or convenience. It came from people encountering Christ through someone willing to go, to serve, and to love.

A Message from Our Clergy

This is the pattern for us.

The second reading challenges us even further: "Always be ready to give an explanation...for your hope, but do it with gentleness and reverence." Notice what Peter does not say. He does not say win the argument. He does not say prove your point. He says to witness—with gentleness.

That is not easy in today's world.

We live in a time where conversations quickly become divisions, and differences often become barriers. Yet the Christian call is different. We are called to be people who hold conviction and compassion at the same time. People who speak truth, but do so in a way that draws others closer, not pushes them away.

And here is where the Gospel gives us hope. Jesus promises, "I will not leave you orphans...you will see me...because I live, you will live." We are not asked to do this on our own. The Holy Spirit—the Advocate—is given to us. God is not distant. He is within us, guiding, strengthening, and reminding us how to love.

So what does this mean for us, practically?

It means that love shows up in the ordinary. It shows up in patience with a colleague, in forgiveness within a family, in choosing to listen rather than react. It shows up in how we treat those who disagree with us, and especially those who may feel unseen or excluded.

It also means that love requires courage. Philip went to Samaria. Peter spoke despite opposition. Jesus loved even unto the cross. Love, real love, always costs something.

But it also brings something greater: joy. Not fleeting happiness, but the deep, abiding joy that comes from living in alignment with God.

This week, we might ask ourselves a simple question: If someone looked at my life, would they see that I love Christ—not just in what I say, but in how I live?

Because in the end, that is the witness that matters most.

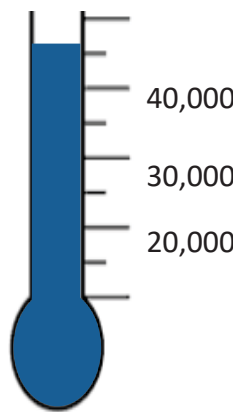

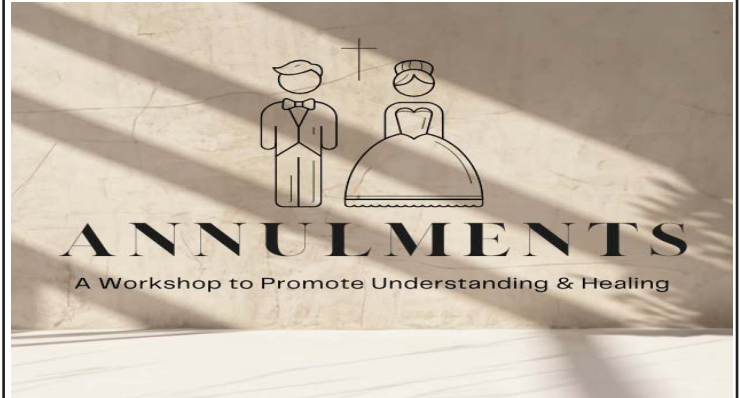

Brazilian & Portuguese Community Information

As leituras deste domingo nos convidam a uma verdade simples, mas exigente: o amor não é um sentimento — é um modo de viver.

No Evangelho, Jesus diz aos Seus discípulos: “Se Me amais, guardareis os Meus mandamentos.” Isso pode soar direto, até óbvio. Mas, se refletirmos sobre isso, percebemos o quão radical é. Jesus não pede admiração. Ele não pede concordância. Ele pede transformação.

O amor, no sentido cristão, não é passivo. Ele se move. Ele age. Ele escolhe.

Uma Mensagem do Nosso Clero

Deacon Jared

Na primeira leitura dos Atos dos Apóstolos, vemos esse amor ser vivido na prática. Filipe vai a Samaria — um lugar que muitos teriam evitado — e proclama Cristo. O resultado não é apenas a fé, mas a cura, a libertação e a alegria. A Escritura nos diz que houve “grande alegria naquela cidade”. Essa alegria não provinha do conforto ou da comodidade; ela vinha do encontro das pessoas com Cristo, por meio de alguém disposto a ir, a servir e a amar.

Este é o padrão para nós.

A segunda leitura nos desafia ainda mais: “Estejam sempre prontos para dar uma explicação... da vossa esperança, mas façam-no com mansidão e reverência.” Observe o que Pedro não diz. Ele não diz para vencer a discussão. Ele não diz para provar o seu ponto. Ele diz para testemunhar — com mansidão.

Isso não é fácil no mundo de hoje.

Vivemos em uma época em que as conversas rapidamente se transformam em divisões, e as diferenças, muitas vezes, tornam-se barreiras. No entanto, o chamado cristão é diferente. Somos chamados a ser pessoas que mantêm, simultaneamente, convicção e compaixão. Pessoas que falam a verdade, mas o fazem de um modo que aproxima os outros, em vez de afastá-los.

E é aqui que o Evangelho nos traz esperança. Jesus promete: “Não vos deixarei órfãos... vós me vereis... porque eu vivo, vós também vivereis”. Não nos é pedido que façamos isso por conta própria. O Espírito Santo — o Advogado — nos é dado. Deus não está distante. Ele está dentro de nós, guiando, fortalecendo e nos lembrando de como amar.

Então, o que isso significa para nós, na prática?

Isso significa que o amor se manifesta no cotidiano. Ele se manifesta na paciência com um colega, no perdão dentro da família, na escolha de ouvir em vez de reagir. Ele se manifesta na maneira como tratamos aqueles que discordam de nós — e, especialmente, aqueles que podem se sentir invisíveis ou excluídos.

Isso também significa que o amor exige coragem. Filipe foi a Samaria. Pedro falou, apesar da oposição. Jesus amou até a cruz. O amor — o amor verdadeiro — sempre custa algo. Mas traz também algo maior: a alegria. Não uma felicidade passageira, mas a alegria profunda e duradoura que provém de viver em alinhamento com Deus.

Esta semana, podemos nos fazer uma pergunta simples: se alguém olhasse para a minha vida, veria que eu amo a Cristo — não apenas no que digo, mas em como vivo?

Porque, no fim das contas, esse é o testemunho que mais importa.




