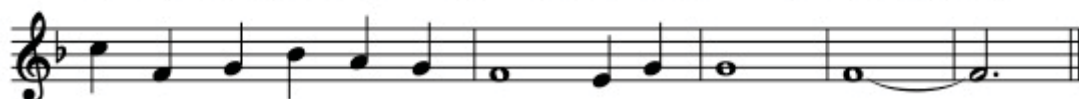

Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

On this, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, we celebrate one of the deepest mysteries of our faith: one God in three Persons — Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. For many of us, the Trinity can feel difficult to explain or fully comprehend. Yet the readings this week remind us that the Trinity is not meant to be solved like a chemistry problem. Rather, the Trinity is meant to be encountered through love, mercy, and relationship.

In the Gospel from John, we hear perhaps the most well-known verse in all of Scripture: “For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son.” What follows is equally important: “For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him.” In a world that often feels quick to judge, divide, shame, and condemn, these words should stop us in our tracks. God’s posture toward humanity is not condemnation — it is salvation. It is mercy. It is accompaniment.

A Message from Our Clergy

This theme echoes throughout the other readings as well. In Exodus, God reveals Himself to Moses as “a merciful and gracious God, slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity.” Notice that before God gives commandments or expectations, He first reveals His mercy. God’s identity is rooted in love. The Trinity teaches us that at the center of all creation is not power, fear, or domination, but communion and self-giving love.

Saint Paul reinforces this beautifully in his closing words to the Corinthians: “Encourage one another, agree with one another, live in peace.” These are not simply nice suggestions. They are reflections of the inner life of the Trinity itself. The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit exist in perfect relationship, unity, and love. If we are created in the image of God, then our lives should reflect those same realities. We are called to build communion rather than division, mercy rather than judgment, and peace rather than conflict.

This is particularly important in our modern world. We live in a time of incredible technological advancement and connectivity, yet many people feel increasingly isolated, anxious, and unseen. We can communicate instantly across the globe, but genuine human communion often feels more difficult than ever. Trinity Sunday reminds us that relationship is not secondary to human life — it is foundational to it. We are made for relationship with God and with one another.

As Christians, we are called to make visible the mercy of God in the world around us. That may mean listening before judging, accompanying someone who is struggling, forgiving an old wound, or simply choosing kindness when anger would be easier. The Trinity reminds us that love is not weakness. Mercy is not compromise. Communion is not naïve.

These are divine realities.



May we remember this week that the God who created us does not seek to condemn us, but to save us. And may our own lives reflect the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit in all we do.

Important Reminder: Proper Receiving of Holy Communion

Catholic parishioners who are properly spiritually disposed, without mortal sin, are welcome to receive Communion at Mass with great reverence.

One option to do this is the encouraged use of the kneelers to receive Communion on the tongue. If you elect to receive Communion in the hand, please place one hand under the other and present an open palm of the hand to receive the Eucharist. Do not grab or take the Eucharist from the minister. When the minister says "The Body of Christ", the proper response is "Amen". The Eucharist must be fully consumed immediately in front of the minister. You must not remove it from your mouth or 'carry' the host back to your pew. Our ministers are trained to monitor for this.

Catholics who are not properly disposed, and non-Catholic friends and visitors are encouraged to come forward with arms crossed over the chest, to receive a blessing from either the priest or the deacon.

Thank you for your cooperation in helping to make receiving Communion a reverent act of spiritual worship.

Brazilian & Portuguese Community Information

A Solenidade da Santíssima Trindade

Nesta Solenidade da Santíssima Trindade, celebramos um dos mistérios mais profundos da nossa fé: um só Deus em três Pessoas — Pai, Filho e Espírito Santo. Para muitos de nós, a Trindade pode parecer difícil de explicar ou de compreender plenamente. No entanto, as leituras desta semana nos recordam que a Trindade não deve ser resolvida como um problema de química. Pelo contrário, a Trindade deve ser encontrada por meio do amor, da misericórdia e do relacionamento.

No Evangelho de João, ouvimos talvez o versículo mais conhecido de toda a Escritura: “Pois Deus amou tanto o mundo que deu o seu único Filho.” O que se segue é igualmente importante: “Pois Deus não enviou o seu Filho ao mundo para condenar o mundo, mas para que o mundo fosse salvo por meio dele.” Em um mundo que muitas vezes parece pronto a julgar, dividir, envergonhar e condenar, estas palavras deveriam nos fazer parar. A postura de Deus para com a humanidade não é de condenação — é de salvação. É de misericórdia. É de acompanhamento.

Uma Mensagem do Nosso Clero

Deacon Jared

Esse tema ecoa também nas demais leituras. No Êxodo, Deus se revela a Moisés como “um Deus misericordioso e compassivo, lento para a ira e rico em bondade e fidelidade”. Note que, antes de estabelecer mandamentos ou expectativas, Deus revela primeiramente a Sua misericórdia. A identidade de Deus está enraizada no amor. A Trindade nos ensina que, no centro de toda a criação, não estão o poder, o medo ou a dominação, mas a comunhão e o amor que se doa.

São Paulo reforça isso de maneira belíssima em suas palavras finais aos Coríntios: “Encorajem-se uns aos outros, vivam em harmonia, vivam em paz.” Estas não são meras sugestões agradáveis. São reflexos da vida interior da própria Trindade. O Pai, o Filho e o Espírito Santo existem em perfeita relação, unidade e amor. Se fomos criados à imagem de Deus, então nossas vidas devem refletir essas mesmas realidades. Somos chamados a construir a comunhão em vez da divisão, a misericórdia em vez do julgamento e a paz em vez do conflito.

Isso é particularmente importante em nosso mundo moderno. Vivemos em uma época de incrível avanço tecnológico e conectividade; no entanto, muitas pessoas sentem-se cada vez mais isoladas, ansiosas e invisíveis. Podemos nos comunicar instantaneamente com qualquer lugar do globo, mas a genuína comunhão humana muitas vezes parece mais difícil do que nunca. O Domingo da Trindade nos recorda que o relacionamento não é secundário na vida humana — é fundamental para ela. Fomos feitos para o relacionamento com Deus e uns com os outros.

Como cristãos, somos chamados a tornar visível a misericórdia de Deus no mundo ao nosso redor. Isso pode significar ouvir antes de julgar, acompanhar alguém que está passando por dificuldades, perdoar uma ferida antiga ou, simplesmente, escolher a bondade quando a raiva seria o caminho mais fácil. A Trindade nos lembra que o amor não é fraqueza. A misericórdia não é concessão. A comunhão não é ingenuidade. Estas são realidades divinas.



Que, nesta semana, nos lembremos de que o Deus que nos criou não busca nos condenar, mas nos salvar. E que nossas próprias vidas reflitam a graça do Senhor Jesus Cristo, o amor de Deus e a comunhão do Espírito Santo em tudo o que fazemos.


