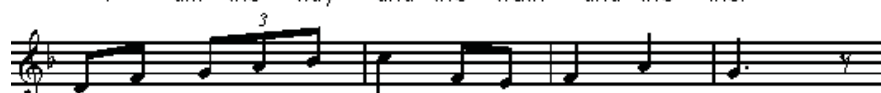

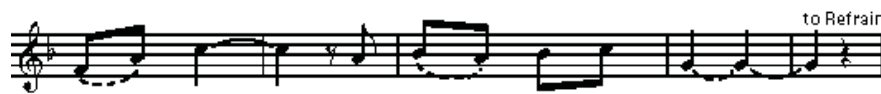

Fifth Sunday of Easter, May 3, 2026

This Sunday's readings invite us into a powerful truth about the life of the Church: growth always brings both opportunity and tension. In the First Reading, we hear that "the number of the disciples was increasing," yet with that growth came complaint—widows were being overlooked in the daily distribution. The early Church, even filled with the Holy Spirit, was not immune to human struggle. And yet, what unfolds in Acts of the Apostles 6:1–7 is not division—but discernment.

The Apostles respond with clarity and humility. They recognize that their primary calling is "to prayer and to the ministry of the word," and so they invite the community to raise up others—men "filled with the Spirit and wisdom"—to serve at table. This moment is often seen as the origin of the diaconate, a ministry rooted not in hierarchy, but in service. It is a reminder that the Church thrives when each vocation is lived fully and faithfully.

A Message from Our Clergy

Deacon Jared

As a deacon, this passage is deeply personal. The call of the diaconate is not simply to "help," but to stand at the intersection of Word, Sacrament, and Charity—to ensure that no one is forgotten. The problem in Acts was not just logistical; it was pastoral. A group of vulnerable people felt unseen. The solution was not efficiency alone—it was Spirit-filled service.

This same theme echoes in the Gospel, where Jesus tells us, "I am the way and the truth and the life". Thomas seeks clarity, Philip seeks understanding—and Jesus responds not with abstraction, but with relationship. "Whoever has seen me has seen the Father." The message is clear: the way forward is not simply about structures or systems, but about embodying Christ.

When we place these readings together, we see something profound. The Church grows not merely by proclamation, nor solely by service, but by holding both together. The Apostles did not abandon the Word to serve tables, nor did they ignore the needs of the poor. Instead, they expanded the mission. They trusted the Spirit to raise up new leaders. And the result? "The word of God continued to spread, and the number of the disciples increased greatly".

There is a lesson here for us today. In our parishes, families, and communities, we often encounter moments of tension—times when needs outpace resources, when voices feel unheard, when growth stretches us beyond our comfort. The temptation is to retreat, to centralize, or to control. But the early Church shows us another way: to listen, to discern, and to empower.

The diaconate, in a particular way, stands as a sign of this balance. Deacons are ordained not to replace the laity, but to animate the Church's call to service. They remind us that charity is not optional—it is constitutive of who we are as the Body of Christ. At the same time, they serve in communion with priests and bishops, ensuring that service flows from and leads back to the Eucharist.

Ultimately, this Sunday is about trust—trust that the Holy Spirit is still at work, just as powerfully as in the days of the Apostles. Trust that when we respond to real needs with humility and wisdom, God will multiply the fruits. And trust that when we walk in the way of Christ—serving, listening, and loving—we become, together, the living Church. And perhaps most importantly, we are reminded: no one should be overlooked. Not then. Not now. Not ever.

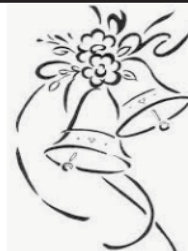

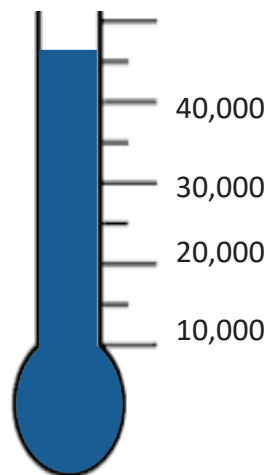

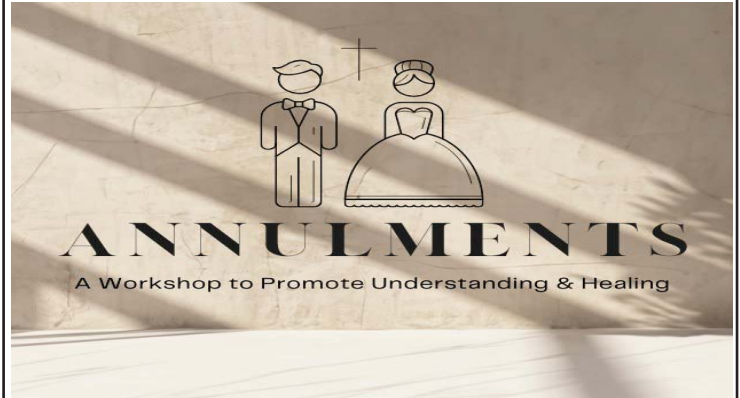

Brazilian & Portuguese Community Information

Quinto Domingo da Páscoa, 3 de maio de 2026

As leituras deste domingo nos convidam a uma verdade poderosa sobre a vida da Igreja: o crescimento traz sempre tanto oportunidade quanto tensão. Na Primeira Leitura, ouvimos que “o número dos discípulos aumentava”; contudo, com esse crescimento, surgiram reclamações — as viúvas estavam sendo negligenciadas na distribuição diária. A Igreja primitiva, mesmo repleta do Espírito Santo, não estava imune às lutas humanas. E, no entanto, o que se desenrola em Atos dos Apóstolos 6,1–7 não é divisão — mas discernimento.

Os Apóstolos respondem com clareza e humildade. Eles reconhecem que seu chamado primordial é “à oração e ao ministério da palavra” e, assim, convidam a comunidade a suscitar outros — homens “cheios do Espírito e de sabedoria” — para servir à mesa. Este momento é frequentemente visto como a origem do diaconato, um ministério enraizado não na hierarquia, mas no serviço. É um lembrete de que a Igreja prospera quando cada vocação é vivida plena e fielmente.

Uma Mensagem do Nosso Clero

Deacon Jared

Como diácono, esta passagem é profundamente pessoal. O chamado do diaconato não consiste simplesmente em “ajudar”, mas em situar-se na interseção entre a Palavra, o Sacramento e a Caridade — para garantir que ninguém seja esquecido. O problema em Atos não era apenas logístico; era pastoral. Um grupo de pessoas vulneráveis sentia-se invisível. A solução não foi apenas a eficiência — foi um serviço repleto do Espírito.

Esse mesmo tema ecoa no Evangelho, onde Jesus nos diz: “Eu sou o caminho, a verdade e a vida”. Tomé busca clareza; Filipe busca compreensão — e Jesus responde não com abstração, mas com relacionamento. “Quem me viu, viu o Pai.” A mensagem é clara: o caminho a seguir não diz respeito simplesmente a estruturas ou sistemas, mas sim a encarnar Cristo.

Quando reunimos essas leituras, percebemos algo profundo. A Igreja cresce não apenas pela proclamação, nem unicamente pelo serviço, mas ao manter ambos unidos. Os Apóstolos não abandonaram a Palavra para servir às mesas, nem ignoraram as necessidades dos pobres. Em vez disso, expandiram a missão. Confiaram no Espírito para suscitar novos líderes. E o resultado? “A palavra de Deus continuava a se propagar, e o número de discípulos aumentava consideravelmente”.

Há aqui uma lição para nós, hoje. Em nossas paróquias, famílias e comunidades, frequentemente nos deparamos com momentos de tensão — momentos em que as necessidades superam os recursos, em que vozes parecem não ser ouvidas, em que o crescimento nos desafia para além da nossa zona de conforto. A tentação é recuar, centralizar ou controlar. Mas a Igreja primitiva nos aponta outro caminho: ouvir, discernir e empoderar.

O diaconato, de modo particular, constitui-se como um sinal desse equilíbrio. Os diáconos são ordenados não para substituir os leigos, mas para animar o chamado da Igreja ao serviço. Eles nos recordam que a caridade não é opcional — é constitutiva de quem somos como Corpo de Cristo. Ao mesmo tempo, servem em comunhão com os sacerdotes e bispos, assegurando que o serviço emane da Eucaristia e a ela retorne.

Em última análise, este domingo trata-se de confiança — a confiança de que o Espírito Santo continua agindo, com a mesma potência dos dias dos Apóstolos. A confiança de que, quando respondemos a necessidades reais com humildade e sabedoria, Deus multiplicará os frutos. E a confiança de que, quando caminhamos no caminho de Cristo — servindo, ouvindo e amando —, nos tornamos, juntos, a Igreja viva. E, talvez o mais importante: somos lembrados de que ninguém deve ser negligenciado. Nem naquela época. Nem agora. Nem nunca.


