I don't know about you, but fairness is something I value deeply. We are taught that if we work hard, do the right thing, and put in the time, we will be rewarded. In other words, we live in a world where we expect to get what we earn. It's human nature. Then, enter today's Gospel, a Gospel that challenges us. In today's Gospel, Jesus tells us about a landowner who hired people throughout the day to work in his vineyard. Some begin first thing in the morning, working all day long in the sweltering heat. Others arrive at noon, others at three, and yet others at the very end of the day at five. At the end of the day, regardless of when they started, each worker receives the same payment.

What was your reaction when you first read that Gospel? If you are like me, you thought, "That's not fair!"

As a dean, professor, and scientist, I understand that reaction. I spend much of my own professional life in a world where we measure things. Students earn grades and degrees. Faculty earn promotions. People earn credentials. Experiments lead to publications and promotion. Hard work matters, and there is nothing wrong with recognizing it. In my work, though, I've learned that we have to meet people where they are. That is, not everyone arrives at the same time. Some students go directly from high school to college. Others arrive at 30, 40, 50 years old, or even older. Life took them on a different path. When that student graduates, we celebrate their success equally to that of the 22-year-old graduating. There are some parallels to the vineyard in this, I think.

A Message from Our Clergy

Deacon Jared

I remember thinking about this idea of fairness when I was in formation for the permanent diaconate. It always fascinated me that a cradle Catholic might spend an entire life trying to follow Christ, going to Mass, receiving the sacraments, praying, serving others, falling down and getting back up, while another person might come to recognize Jesus as Lord and Savior only at the very end of life. God welcomes them both into heaven. Again, our human heart asks, "How is that fair?" Isaiah gives us the answer: God tells us that His thoughts are not our thoughts, nor are His ways our ways. God's generosity is beyond human calculation. Isaiah also tells us to seek the Lord while He may be found and to turn to Him for mercy because He is generous and forgiving. It's never too late to turn to God.

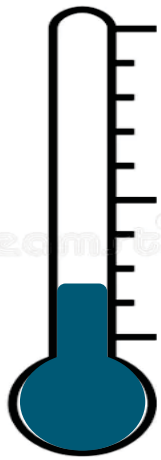
St. Paul takes us deeper. Writing to the Philippians, he says, "For to me life is Christ, and death is gain." Paul understands what the workers in the vineyard are ultimately working toward. Our reward isn't something God owes us. Our reward is Christ himself, eternal life. It is not a paycheck for hours worked, but a gift of grace. That is why the landowner's question is so important: "Are you envious because I am generous?" I think this is the question we are asked to pray on this week.

When I look at my own life, I can point to things I have worked hard for. But I can point to other things, family, faith, people who loved me, opportunities I have received, and God's forgiveness, that I could never have claimed to have earned. They are gifts.

I think the Gospel is reminding us that it isn't about fairness, but instead about God's generosity and love. Some enter the vineyard early. Others arrive much later. Isaiah reminds us to seek Him. Paul reminds us that our life is Christ. And Jesus reminds us that the invitation remains open. What matters is that when the Lord comes looking for us, we answer His call and rejoice whenever another person answers it too.

Help Us Repeal Chapter 188 Newly Signed Abortion Law

Greetings, brothers and sisters in Christ. On August 10, Governor Healey signed into law Chapter 188, a bill to allow unrestricted abortions up to the point of birth. No medical necessity or medical review is required. It does not even require the procedure to be done in a hospital. We need to repeal it, and you can help! Our Knights of Columbus - Council 81, is organizing a signature drive to repeal this law. Brazilian & Portuguese Community Information

Não sei quanto a você, mas a justiça é algo que valorizo profundamente. Aprendemos que, se trabalharmos duro, fizermos a coisa certa e nos dedicarmos, seremos recompensados. Em outras palavras, vivemos em um mundo onde esperamos receber pelo que conquistamos. É da natureza humana. Então, chegamos ao Evangelho de hoje — um Evangelho que nos desafia. Nele, Jesus nos fala de um proprietário de terras que contratou pessoas ao longo do dia para trabalhar em sua vinha. Alguns começam logo cedo, trabalhando o dia todo sob um calor intenso. Outros chegam ao meio-dia, outros às três e, ainda outros, bem no final do dia, às cinco. Ao final do dia, independentemente de quando começaram, cada trabalhador recebe o mesmo pagamento.

Qual foi a sua reação quando leu aquele Evangelho pela primeira vez? Se você é como eu, pensou: “Isso não é justo!”

Como diretor acadêmico, professor e cientista, compreendo essa reação. Passei grande parte da minha vida profissional em um mundo onde mensuramos as coisas. Estudantes obtêm notas e

diplomas. Professores conquistam promoções. Pessoas adquirem qualificações. Experimentos resultam em publicações e ascensão na carreira. O trabalho árduo é importante, e não há nada de errado em reconhecê-lo. No entanto, aprendi em meu trabalho que precisamos encontrar as pessoas onde elas estão. Ou seja, nem todos chegam ao mesmo tempo. Alguns estudantes vão direto do ensino médio para a faculdade. Outros chegam aos 30, 40, 50 anos ou até mais velhos; a vida os levou por caminhos diferentes. Quando esse estudante se forma, celebramos seu sucesso da mesma maneira que celebramos o do jovem de 22 anos que está se graduando. Creio que há paralelos com o vinhedo nisso.

Uma Mensagem do Nosso Clero

Deacon Jared

Lembro-me de refletir sobre essa ideia de justiça quando estava em formação para o diaconato permanente. Sempre me fascinou o fato de que um católico de berço pode passar a vida inteira tentando seguir a Cristo — indo à Missa, recebendo os sacramentos, rezando, servindo ao próximo, caindo e levantando-se —, enquanto outra pessoa pode vir a reconhecer Jesus como Senhor e Salvador apenas no final da vida. Deus acolhe a ambos no céu. Mais uma vez, o nosso coração humano pergunta: “Como isso é justo?” Isaías nos dá a resposta: Deus nos diz que os Seus pensamentos não são os nossos pensamentos, nem os Seus caminhos são os nossos caminhos. A generosidade de Deus está além de qualquer cálculo humano. Isaías também nos diz para buscar o Senhor enquanto Ele se deixa encontrar e para recorrer a Ele em busca de misericórdia, pois Ele é generoso e perdoador. Nunca é tarde demais para voltar-se para Deus.

São Paulo nos conduz a uma compreensão mais profunda. Escrevendo aos Filipenses, ele diz: “Para mim, o viver é Cristo e o morrer é lucro”. Paulo compreende o objetivo final do trabalho dos operários na vinha. Nossa recompensa não é algo que Deus nos deve. Nossa recompensa é o próprio Cristo, a vida eterna. Não se trata de um pagamento por horas trabalhadas, mas de um dom da graça. É por isso que a pergunta do proprietário da vinha é tão importante: “Você está com inveja porque sou generoso?” Creio que esta é a pergunta sobre a qual somos convidados a meditar e rezar nesta semana.

Ao olhar para a minha própria vida, consigo apontar coisas pelas quais trabalhei arduamente. Mas também posso apontar outras coisas — família, fé, pessoas que me amaram, oportunidades que recebi e o perdão de Deus — que jamais poderia alegar ter conquistado por mérito próprio. São dons.

Creio que o Evangelho nos recorda que não se trata de justiça, mas sim da generosidade e do amor de Deus. Alguns entram na vinha cedo; outros chegam muito mais tarde. Isaías nos lembra de buscá-Lo; Paulo nos lembra de que a nossa vida é Cristo; e Jesus nos lembra de que o convite permanece aberto. O que importa é que, quando o Senhor vier ao nosso encontro, nós respondamos ao Seu chamado e nos alegremos sempre que outra pessoa também o atender.

Brazilian & Portuguese Community Information

Hoje no XXV Domingo do Tempo Comum, somos convidados à meditar sobre a generosidade infinita de Deus, cuja lógica difere da justiça humana, seguindo a medida da Graça. A parábola contada por Jesus no Evangelho de Mt 20,1-16 quer nos mostrar que os trabalhadores da primeira hora são os judeus e os outros trabalhadores somos nós que ao longo do tempo fomos entrando na igreja de Deus, a construindo... O Senhor abriu as portas da Salvação à todos, pois se para uns se mostrou bondoso desde a primeira hora, para todos os outros Ele também se mostrará bondoso. Não há pois lugar para a inveja onde tudo é puro dom gratuito de Deus. (Secretaria Nacional de Liturgia)

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NOTE FROM FR. BERT: PARISH CENTER "PC CLEAN UP"

Saint Michael Parish · Celebrating 150 Years of Faith

Greetings Brothers and Sisters,

I am very grateful to report that many parishioners have responded with much generosity toward our Parish Center Cleanup Project. To date, we have received \$25,190 towards our current estimate of **\$95,000** for the Parish Center Cleanup Project.

Our Parish Center, as you are aware, is a hub of our faith community. The building hosts numerous activities of our Parish Life such as the classrooms for our faith formation programs of our children and adults, Faith enrichment groups, many social events and group meetings. The Parish Center also provides office space for the Parish administrative staff.

Since this building supports much of the Parish community life, it must be a safe, healthy environment for those who visit and work there. By making the necessary improvements of this project, we will ensure that this continues.

As we celebrate our "150th Anniversary" year as a Faith Community, let us gratefully reflect on the gifts that we have received from the generations before us. We have the responsibility to preserve our sacred places and hand them on, in good condition and with renewed life, to those who will come after us.

I would like to ask for you to prayerfully consider contributing to this vital project of the Parish Center. The large, unexpected costs of this

project do not allow for our parish to use our weekly offertory collections to pay for this project. Because our weekly offertory funds are necessary to pay for our annual operational costs of Saint Michael Parish, we need to raise additional funds for our Parish Center Cleanup Project. Therefore, I am humbly requesting that your contribution to the Parish Center is made separately while you continue to maintain your generous weekly offerings.

The Saint Michael Parish Pastoral Council, the Parish Finance Committee and the Parish Fundraising Committee believe, based on the size of our parish and the stewardship of our faith community, that we can reach our total goal of **\$95,000**.

This invitation is not simply about repairing buildings, but more importantly, it is about our stewardship, our gratitude and our love for Christ, His Church, and the "People of God" who have come before us and who will follow us.
