Regulation Format BEST-BALL MATCH PLAY

Competition format for all regulation matches shall be Net Four-Ball, the net better ball of two players (team) against the net better ball of the other two players (opposing team). One (1) point is to be awarded for each hole won and half (1/2) a point is to be awarded for halved (tied) holes.

The team that accumulates the highest point total in each flight over 5 regulation matches shall advance to the Championship Shootout. A Wild Card spot will be awarded to the team with the highest point total accumulated over five rounds but did not finish first in the flight. In the event of a draw, cumulative point totals from Saturday and Sunday will be compared. If tie still exists, Sunday points will compared. If a tie remains, Sunday scores are compared.

Shootout Format TRUE ALTERNATE SHOT
