Alpha & Omega

*“I am the Alpha and the Omega—the beginning and the end,”
says the Lord God. “I am the one who is, who always was,
and who is still to come—the Almighty One.
Revelation 1:8 NLT*

Alpha and Omega are the first and last letters of the Greek alphabet. In Revelation 1:8, Jesus is declaring that He is the beginning and the end. In Colossians 1:16, we are told that in the beginning Jesus created all things. And in the book of Revelation, we see Jesus completing the work He started.
