What is Realm? Realm is a real ministry tool.

Realm is an online ministry tool designed for real time connection. It helps New Covenant Community Church connect with you and you connect with us. If you consider yourself part of this church family, you'll love it. Realm allows you to manage your personal information and who is allowed to see it, control your giving, and keep in touch with the groups that matter to you.

Why use Realm? Realm strengthens church connections.

Being the church doesn't just happen at the church. Realm helps us serve you better and leads this church well between Sundays. Everyone can be connected from anywhere at any time, right from our mobile devices. It engages everyone in the life of our church by supporting the healthy relationships essential to our church's mission. We'll stay organized, and you'll stay informed about all of the opportunities for fellowship. When we share life together, we will grow together.

What about my privacy? Realm is safe, private, and secure.

Your privacy is one of our greatest concerns. Realm is only made up of the people in your church, it's not like a social network that's open to everyone. Realm keeps your data safe and gives you control over what information you share and who can see it.

What about giving? Realm gives you control over your giving.

Giving should be easy, and Realm places giving right in the palm of your hands. You may set up recurring gifts, view your giving history, and make changes at any time. Realm automatically records all electronic gifts and adds them to your giving record, making it easy for you to give, and easy for our treasurer to track. Our Treasurer also enters all in-person giving (cash and check) into Realm, so even if you do not use the online giving tool, you can still view and print your giving statements.

Creating a Realm Account through New Covenant Community Church

FROM A DESKTOP COMPUTER/LAPTOP:

- 1. Navigate to our website at www.new-covenant.org/realm and click "Sign Up for Realm." You can also type the following web address directly into your preferred browser (Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge, Safari, etc.):

 https://onrealm.org/newcovenantcommunitychurch/Account/Start?mode=signUpOpen.
- 2. Enter your email address, first and last name, birthday (optional), and phone number, as directed. Click "Continue"
- 3. You will be prompted to verify your email address. Navigate to your email inbox and click the link in the email that appears from New Covenant Community Church.
- 4. Upon clicking the verification link, create your password, as prompted.
- 5. You have successfully created your Realm account through New Covenant Community Church!
 - a. You will be directed to a screen that offers the option to download the mobile app. While on a computer/laptop, to bypass this option, remain on the screen for about 10 seconds, or click on the blue link towards the bottom of the screen, directing you to continue in the browser.
- 6. At the top-right of the screen, click the select "My Profile." Within here:
 - a. Click and edit your contact information (email address, physical address, phone number) and personal information.
 - b. Click and edit what information you are comfortable sharing with different New Covenant Community Church Realm users.
 - i. Anyone in the church anyone with a Realm account through New Covenant Community Church can see your information.
 - ii. Leaders & group/serving team members only people in groups you have joined, group leaders, and church staff can see your information.
 - iii. Leaders only group leaders and church staff can see your information.
 - iv. Users with permission only only church staff can see your information.

Note: "Custom Privacy" gives you more control over who sees what specific information.

7. Save the following web address to access your Realm account in the future: <u>e.onrealm.org</u>. You can also access your Realm account by going to our website at <u>www.new-covenant.org/realm</u>, and selecting "Sign in here."

FROM A MOBILE DEVICE:

- 1. Navigate to our website at www.new-covenant.org/realm and click "Sign Up for Realm." You can also type the following web address directly into your preferred browser (Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge, Safari, etc.):

 https://onrealm.org/newcovenantcommunitychurch/Account/Start?mode=signUpOpen.
- 2. Enter your email address, first and last name, birthday (optional), and phone number, as directed. Click "Continue."
- 3. You will be prompted to verify your email address. Navigate to your email inbox and click the link in the email that appears from New Covenant Community Church.
- 4. Upon clicking the verification link, create your password, as prompted.
- 5. You have successfully created your Realm account through New Covenant Community Church!
 - a. You will be directed to a screen that offers the option to download the mobile app. We recommend downloading and signing into the mobile app to continue
 - b. If you wish to bypass this option, however, remain on the screen for about 10 seconds, or click on the blue link towards the bottom of the screen, directing you to continue in the browser.
- 6. If continuing in your browser: (If continuing in the mobile app, skip to Step 7.)
 - a. After having created your account, at the top-left of the screen, select the icon. At the bottom-left of the resulting menu, click the and select "My Profile." Within here:
 - i. Click and edit your contact information (email address, physical address, phone number) and personal information.
 - ii. Click Manage Privacy and edit what information you are comfortable sharing with different New Covenant Community Church Realm users.
 - 1. Anyone in the church anyone with a Realm account through New Covenant Community Church can see your information.

- 2. Leaders & group/serving team members only people in groups you have joined, group leaders, and church staff can see your information.
- 3. *Leaders* only group leaders and church staff can see your information.
- 4. *Users with permission only* only church staff can see your information.

Note: "Custom Privacy" gives you more control over who sees what specific information.

- iii. You can also click the circle next to your name to upload a profile picture.
- b. Save the following web address to access your Realm account in the future: e.onrealm.org. You can also access your Realm account by going to our website at www.new-covenant.org/realm, and selecting "Sign in here."
- 7. If continuing in the *mobile app* (search for "Realm Connect" in your app store to download):
 - a. Click the "More" icon at the bottom-right of your screen.
 - b. Click "Profile" to edit your *contact information* (email address, phone number, physical address) and *personal information*.
 - i. When editing your contact information, you can decide who can see specific information:
 - 1. Anyone in the church anyone with a Realm account through New Covenant Community Church can see your information.
 - 2. People in my groups only people in groups you have joined, group leaders, and church staff can see your information.
 - 3. *Visible to group leaders* only group leaders and church staff can see your information.
 - 4. Church staff only only church staff can see your information.

- 2. Click in the search or begin typing in the name of the person for whom you are searching. A list of profiles that match your entries will appear. When you see the name you want, click on it to see the information which they have elected to share.

At the top-right of the page, click on the dropdown next to your name & profile image:

- 1. **My Profile** Edit your contact information and privacy settings at any time, and see all groups of which you are a participant.
 - a. Click the icon to add family members to your profile and invite them to join Realm (optional).

- 2. **Manage Privacy** Manage your privacy settings at any time.
- 3. Manage Account
 - a. Account Update your account email address and change your password.
 - b. Payments Edit your payment information which is used for online giving (optional).
- 4. Notification Settings Manage where and how you will receive notifications.

- 2. **Chat** Like texting or other chat services, connect with other New Covenant Community Church Realm users, or group members, in group chats or individual message chains.

Under the "Events" tab:

- 3. My Events See events for which groups you are a part of are holding.
- 4. All Events See all upcoming events.

Under the "Giving" tab:

- 1. See your personal giving history.
 - a. You can only print your giving statement in a browser on a computer or on your mobile device – not within the mobile app.
 - b. Our Treasurer also enters all in-person giving (cash and check) into Realm, so even if you do not use the online giving tool, you can still view your giving in the app.
