- 1. Public Comments: Christine Campbell inquired when the project will start.

- 5. Burd moved, Reisinger seconded, motion carried unanimously to transfer \$2,000 from the regular checking account to the PENNVEST/PennWorks account
- 6. Burd moved, Sheaffer seconded, motion carried unanimously to approve Campbell to e-sign all funding requests that involve project costs that have been approved by the Authority Board.
- 7. Burd moved, Sheaffer seconded, motion carried unanimously to approve Campbell to sign for the first PennWorks requisition not to exceed \$36,000.
- 8. HRG & HTMA to schedule a conference call to go over and ascertain any more allowable reimbursable costs incurred by HTMA to date.
- 9. Postick reported that the reimbursement agreement signed, no notification of funds being transferred yet.
- 10. Postick reported that the tentative preconstruction is being scheduled for 9.3.2019 at the Pinnacle community room. This will include a discussion over contactor schedules and where the work will be done first. Should have a better idea by the time of the meeting.
- 11. The agreements for the Juniata Parkway Pump Station have been finalized.
- 12. Campbell reported that OTMA seems to be agreeable to do the billing and collecting funds for HTMA. They will be discussing at their next meeting.
- 13. Campbell reported that Cupp Insurance declined to offer HTMA a quote unless they "Howe Township" would switch to them for full coverage.
- 14. Moore Insurance confirmed that HTMA is covered under the Howe Township liability and errors & omissions insurance.
- 15. Postick reported that HRG would be able to resubmit for CFA grant for W. Shortcut Road extension when the grant period opens and will submit a cost proposal.
- 16. Reisinger moved, Sheaffer seconded, motion carried unanimously to adjourn at 6:10pm.
