TRAFFIC REGULATION NOTICE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, that the Oxfordshire County Council

**TEMPORARILY PROHIBITS THE USE OF AND WAITING ON THE HIGHWAY
BY ALL MOTOR VEHICLES**

- LOCATION:** Cogges / Witney, Coggers Hill Road & Stanton Harcourt Road (between B4022 and Tar Road)
- REASON:** To facilitate pre-surfacing dressing works
- DURATION:** Start on 21 November 2025
This will operate between 09:30 and 15:30
(Traffic Regulation Notices cover a maximum of 5 consecutive days.)
- ACCESS:** Limited access will be maintained for emergency service vehicles and for frontages within the closed section of road, subject to the progress of the works. Access will be maintained for cyclist and pedestrians

The “No Waiting” restriction means that wherever there are in place yellow “No Waiting” cones, you will not be able to park vehicles on the highway.

SUGGESTED ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: via Tar Road - Cogges Lane - B4449 - Stanton Harcourt - Station Road - Chapel Road - South Leigh Road - B4022 and vice versa
