Disbursements

Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by us. You are expected to pay for these items at the time the contract is entered into. The following are some items that are often identified as disbursements.

Coroner's fee – this is a fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place. The fee is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario.

Clergy honorarium & church fees – this is an amount paid to the clergy for their services. In some cases, the amount is set by the clergy, in others it is an amount to be determined by you.

Newspaper or radio notices – these are charges for death notices placed in newspapers or radio or other media outlets.

Municipal death registration fee – this is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death. The fee is set by the municipality and may very.

Cemetery Expenses – this is an amount paid to cemeteries for new purchases and the cost to open or close a grave.

Cremation Expenses – this is the amount paid to the crematory for the cremation process.

Payment

Unless otherwise specified, payment is due within 10 days of signing the contract. Payment may be made by cash, cheque, debit, and most major credit cards. Payment plans are also available to meet most budgets. Financing charges apply to payment plans.
