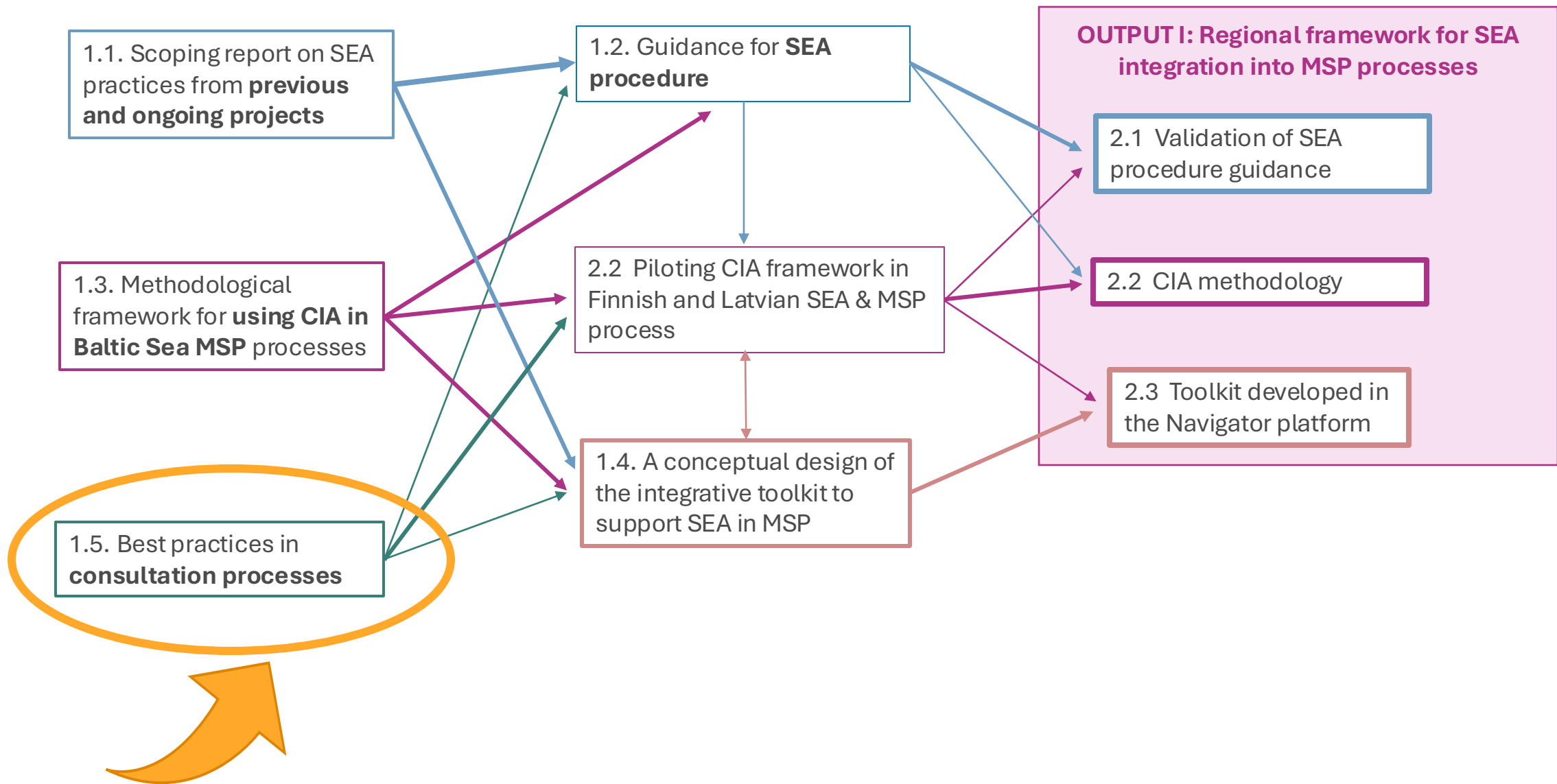


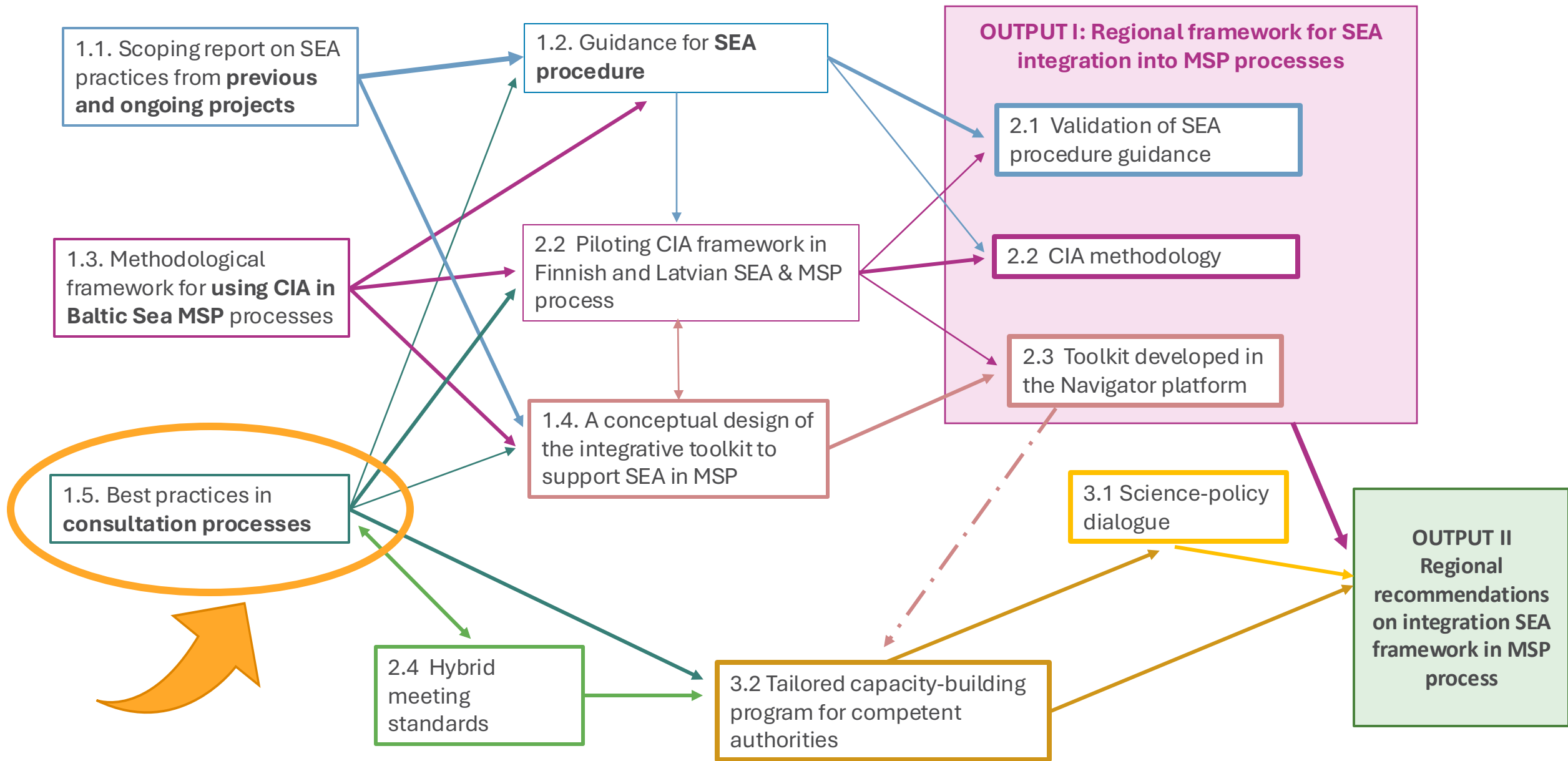
HOW?

- Science-policy dialogue





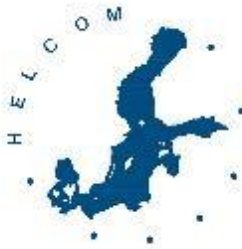


WHEN WILL IT ALL BE DONE?
