Andy Leggett, '1904' Entertainer Member, Saxophonist & Clarinettist

Andy is speaking about some great musical prodigies in his family line. It begins with his great-great-grandfather, Joseph Isaiah Moore, who started out as a Kidderminster carpet weaver ... somehow acquired a harp and the ability to play the thing and became a music professor.

Then, more importantly, his tenth child - Joseph Warwick Moore (1869-1931) became an accomplished violinist, pianist and composer. He worked at Drury Lane Theatre, other theatres in Newport Mon., Malvern and Bournemouth and eventually lived as the Musical Director in the Grand Theatre, Southampton.

All the while he was having his multi-part piano compositions published all over the English-speaking world. The Bechstein piano company sponsored the German pianist, Uwe Roessler, to record a CD of his music. **What a story!**
