PROCEDURES FOR SETTING/CANCELLING A CIVIL MOTION:

All documents necessary for the court's consideration of the motion must have been FILED before the motion can be noticed for hearing.

The notice of hearing must be filed at least **TEN (10)** days prior to the hearing.

All Forrest and Perry County motions are to be noticed for 9:00 in Forrest County (630 Main Street, 3rd Floor, Hattiesburg, MS 39401).

Email one copy of the notice and one copy of the motion to Clarissa at ckelly@forrestcountymys.us **or** mail them to P.O. Box 309, Hattiesburg, MS 39403. Any document(s) **over 25 pages** must be mailed.

One copy of any response, rebuttal, and/or reply shall be emailed to Clarissa.

Email a copy of just the notice to Sandra Mohler at smohler@forrestcountymys.us

If your case is a Perry County case, the movant is responsible for ensuring that all documents associated with the set motion have been submitted to Clarissa.
