Introduction to the Liturgy of the Day

We recall the Magi, who, drawn by the star, journeyed from distant lands to find the newborn king of the Jews and present Him with their finest gifts. We each make our own journey to the Lord, and when we come to celebrate the Eucharist, we offer our finest gifts – our prayers, our lives, our future – to Him whose birth we have just marked. Let us, in turn, welcome all those who are making their journeys from near and far to worship the Lord.

It is a long-held Catholic tradition to bless one's home on (or near) the celebration of the Epiphany by using chalk to write a special inscription above the home's entrance. **This weekend, the Spiritual Life Committee has provided Blessing kits at Mass for you to take home and participate in this tradition. There are instructions and a prayer included!**

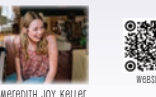
