FROM THE DESK OF THE PRIEST:

One of the most difficult struggles we face is confronting our weaknesses. This Lenten journey, which we have already begun, will lead us to very intense battles. In the temptations of each day, a battle will be waged within us, especially regarding the sacrifices we have chosen to make. This is the nature of this season, and it is good that it is so, with offerings and struggles. But if we follow Jesus and are convinced that, whatever the cost, we will reach Calvary with Him, then let us walk as He did, guided by the Spirit. Let us allow the Spirit to guide us during this Lenten season, and every temptation will be overcome. Lent, therefore, is the time of the Spirit and us, in a close, supportive, and loving relationship with the Spirit. Otherwise, it will be very difficult to follow Jesus. Certainly, there are small “consolations” in everything that tempts us, but the Spirit multiplies them for those who are willing to accept Him. Those who are unwilling will only obtain the limited “consolation” of the object of their temptation.


**FEBRUARY 22, 2026 –
FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT**

Introduction to the Liturgy of the Day

During the forty-day journey through the desert that we make each Lent, again and again we will find ourselves tempted to do the wrong thing, to overindulge, to lie, to take the easy way out. Fortunately, the Holy Spirit accompanies us to guide us along the right path and lead us back after we lose our way. We recall that, filled with the Holy Spirit, Jesus was able to resist temptation on His journey, even when the devil offered Him the whole world. May we be strengthened regularly by His Body and Blood while on our holy pilgrimage.

THE STATIONS OF THE CROSS, also known as The Way of the Cross, are an act of devotion dating back to early Christianity, following the path of Jesus from His trial in front of Pilate to His burial in the tomb. Along the way, reflections and prayers are offered at key points in the story, focusing on the different aspects of Christ's suffering, and asking us to mourn our sins. While the Stations can be prayed at any time, they are particularly appropriate for Lent.
