FIRST SATURDAY DEVOTION:

Typically, five consecutive Saturdays in reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary

The practice of the First Saturday devotion was requested by **Our Lady of Fatima**, who appeared to three shepherd children in Fatima, Portugal, multiple times starting in 1917.

Later, she repeated her request to Sr. Lucia, the only one still living of the three young children, while she was a postulant sister living in a convent in Spain: *“Look, my daughter, at my Heart, surrounded with thorns with which ungrateful men pierce me at very moment by their blasphemies and ingratitude. You at least try to console me, and say that I promise to assist at the hour of death, with the graces necessary for salvation, all those who, on the first Saturday of five consecutive months, shall confess, receive Holy Communion, recite five Decades of the Rosary, and keep me company for 15 minutes while meditating on the 15 Mysteries of the Rosary, with the intention of making reparation to me.”*

FIRST FRIDAY DEVOTION:

Typically, nine consecutive Fridays in reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

Our Lord appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alcoque, a French nun in the Visitation Order, and gave her the special task to spread devotion to His Most Sacred Heart at a time when religion was growing cold in the hearts of mankind. For those who did this faithfully, He made what St. Margaret Mary referred to as the “Great Promise.”

“I promise you in the unfathomable mercy of my heart that my omnipotent love will procure the grace of final penitence for all those who receive communion on nine successive first Fridays of the month; they will not die in my disfavor, or without having received the sacraments, since my divine heart will be their sure refuge in the last moments of their life.”

GREATER DIFFICULTY, GREATER REWARD

While keeping up with these devotions over five or nine consecutive months is not easy, the reward for making the effort is eternal!

DEVOCIÓN DEL PRIMER SÁBADO:

Normalmente, cinco sábados consecutivos en reparación al Inmaculado Corazón de María

La práctica de la devoción del primer sábado fue solicitada por **Nuestra Señora de Fátima**, quien se apareció a tres pastores en Fátima, Portugal, varias veces a partir de 1917.

Más tarde repitió su petición a la hermana Lucía, la única que seguía viva de los tres niños pequeños, mientras era una hermana postulante que vivía en un convento en España: *“Mira, hija mía, en mi corazón, rodeada de espinas con las que hombres ingratos me atraviesan en el mismo momento con sus blasfemias e ingratitud. Al menos intenta consolarme, y di que prometo asistir en la hora de la muerte, con las gracias necesarias para la salvación, a todos aquellos que, en el primer sábado de cinco meses consecutivos, se confiesen, reciten la Sagrada Comunión, recitan cinco Décadas del Rosario y me acompañen durante 15 minutos mientras meditan en los 15 Misterios del Rosario, con la intención de hacerme reparación.”*

DEVOCIÓN DEL PRIMER VIERNES:

Normalmente, nueve viernes consecutivos en reparación al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús

Nuestro Señor se apareció a Santa Margarita María Alcoque, una monja francesa de la Orden de la Visitación, y le encomendó la tarea especial de difundir la devoción a Su Sagrado Corazón en un momento en que la religión se enfriaba en los corazones de la humanidad. Para quienes lo hicieron fielmente, hizo lo que Santa Margarita María llamó la “Gran Promesa.”

“Os prometo, en la insondable misericordia de mi corazón, que mi amor omnipotente procurará la gracia de la penitencia final para todos los que reciban la comunión en nueve primeros viernes consecutivos del mes; No morirán en mi desgracia, ni sin haber recibido los sacramentos, ya que mi corazón divino será su refugio seguro en los últimos momentos de su vida.”

Introduction to the Liturgy of the Day

Jesus and the prophets teach us how to be generous. A woman in the small village of Shunem regularly invites the prophet Elisha to dine at her home when he passes through town. Eventually, she and her husband arrange a room for him to stay in overnight. Elisha responds to her generosity by promising that she will bear her first son within a year. Jesus tells the apostles that anyone who gives just a cup of cold water to a disciple will be rewarded. Even small acts of human generosity reflect the divine generosity of God. May we all be generous in ways great and small.
