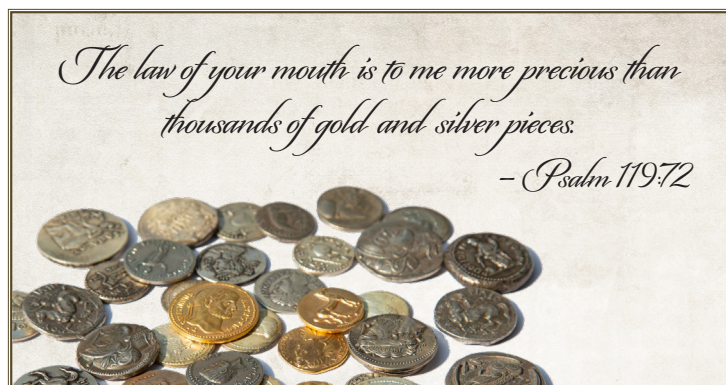
**DECIMOSÉPTIMO DOMINGO
EN TIEMPO ORDINARIO****Introducción a la Liturgia del Día**

Cada domingo cuando nos reunimos para adorar a Dios se nos alimenta primero con la palabra de Dios en las lecturas, el salmo y el Evangelio, y después con el propio cuerpo de Cristo en la Eucaristía. Puede que, por tener ambas cosas a nuestra disposición domingo tras domingo, las demos por supuesto sin percatarnos de que son dones que tenemos que valorar. En el Evangelio de hoy Jesús compara el Reino de los cielos con un gran tesoro escondido en un campo, adquirido por una persona que tuvo la dicha de encontrarlo. Pero nosotros tenemos nuestro tesoro aquí en estos momentos, que nos ha dado el Dios de la infinita generosidad. Que seamos bendecidos con la sabiduría de ver los tesoros que tenemos en la palabra de Dios y en la Eucaristía.

Las gracias que conlleva tener una misa con una intención especial son incalculables.

Dado que la Misa católica es la forma de oración más poderosa, es una práctica común que se ofrezca con una intención específica. Celebrar una misa por alguien es una forma poderosa de interceder o rezar por esa persona. Se pueden solicitar intenciones de misa en nombre de otra persona viva—por ejemplo, la curación de alguien enfermo o para conmemorar un aniversario de boda. Sin embargo, las intenciones de Misa se ofrecen más comúnmente en recuerdo de una persona que ha fallecido. Ofrecemos misas para nuestros seres queridos fallecidos para ayudarles en su viaje al cielo. Oramos con esperanza para que las gracias impartidas por la Misa les conduzcan aún más hacia la eternidad con Dios.

Estas gracias son especialmente importantes para los muertos, ya que ya no pueden rezar por sí mismos. El Papa Francisco dijo que ofrecer la celebración de la Eucaristía para los muertos “es la mejor ayuda espiritual que podemos dar a sus almas, especialmente a las más abandonadas.” **Puedes solicitar una misa en nuestra página web (stmarymagdalenecolumbus.org) o llamando a la Oficina Parroquial. La asignación sugerida para una intención de misa es de 10 dólares.**



July 26, 2026 –

SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**Introduction to the Liturgy of the Day**

Each Sunday when we come together to worship God, we are nourished first by God's Word in the readings, Psalm, and Gospel and then by Christ's own body in the Eucharist. We may take both for granted, because each is available to us every Sunday, but these are gifts that are meant to be treasured. In today's Gospel, Jesus compares the kingdom of heaven to a great treasure buried in a field, bought by a person lucky enough to have found it. But we have our treasure right here and right now, given to us by a God of infinite generosity. May we be blessed with the wisdom to see the treasures we have in the Word and Eucharist.

The graces that come with having a Mass said for a special intention are immeasurable.

Since the Catholic Mass is the most powerful form of prayer, it is a common practice to have it offered for a specific intention. Having a Mass said for someone is a powerful way to intercede or pray for them on their behalf. Mass intentions can be requested on behalf of another living person—for example, the healing of someone who is sick or to commemorate a wedding anniversary. However, Mass intentions are most commonly offered in remembrance of a person who has died.

We offer Masses for our deceased loved ones to aid them in their journeys to heaven. We pray with hope that the graces imparted by the Mass usher them further towards eternity with God.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states: “From the beginning, the Church has honored the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the **Eucharistic sacrifice**, so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God” (CCC 1032).

These graces are especially important for the dead, as they can no longer pray for themselves. Pope Francis said that offering the celebration of the Eucharist for the dead “is the best spiritual help that we can give to their souls, particularly to the most abandoned ones.” **You can request a Mass by email (acarrier@saintmarymag.org), on our website (stmarymagdalenecolumbus.org) or by calling the Parish Office. The suggested stipend for a Mass intention is \$10.00.**

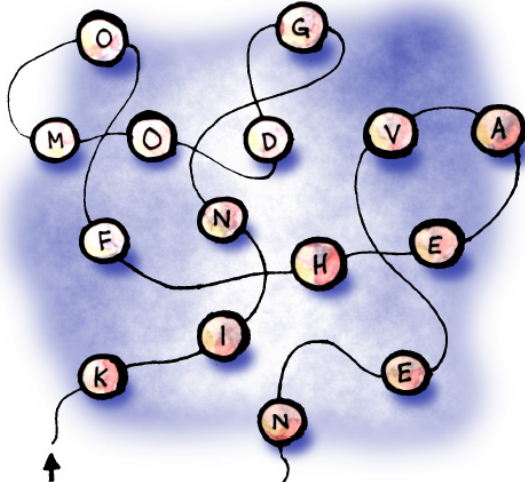

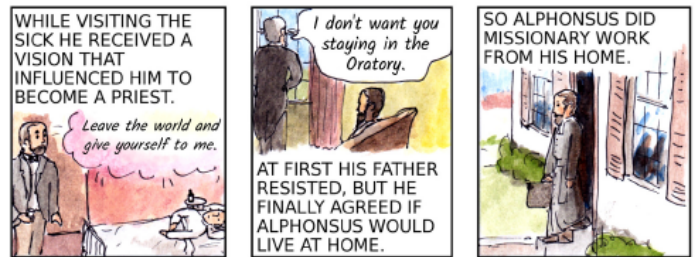
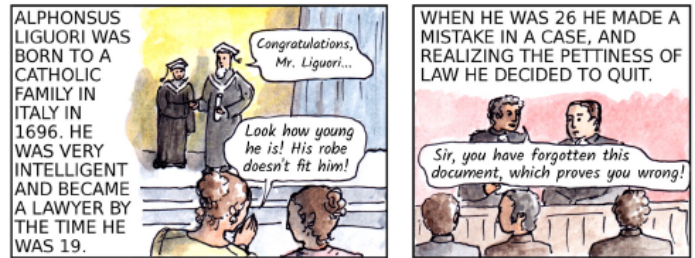
