Introducción a la Liturgia del Día

Jesús nos conduce de nuevo hoy a un lugar solitario adonde lo siguieron millares de personas. A pesar de tener sólo cinco panes y dos pescados, Jesús puede dar de comer a toda la muchedumbre. Nosotros nos reunimos aquí cada domingo, una muchedumbre de sólo unas cuantas docenas o tal vez unos centenares, pero donde podemos recibir el alimento que ahora es el propio cuerpo de Jesús ofrecido y multiplicado para satisfacernos a todos. Podemos tener la seguridad de que Jesús está aquí, que nos habla y nos alimenta igual que hizo aquel maravilloso día, pues así es la manera de obrar de Jesús.

LAS GRACIAS QUE CONLLEVA TENER UNA MISA CON UNA INTENCIÓN ESPECIAL SON INCALCULABLES

Dado que la Misa católica es la forma de oración más poderosa, es una práctica común que se ofrezca con una intención específica. Celebrar una misa por alguien es una forma poderosa de interceder o rezar por esa persona. Se pueden solicitar intenciones de misa en nombre de otra persona viva—por ejemplo, la curación de alguien enfermo o para conmemorar un aniversario de boda. Sin embargo, las intenciones de Misa se ofrecen más comúnmente en recuerdo de una persona que ha fallecido. Ofrecemos misas para nuestros seres queridos fallecidos para ayudarles en su viaje al cielo. Oramos con esperanza para que las gracias impartidas por la Misa les conduzcan aún más hacia la eternidad con Dios.

Estas gracias son especialmente importantes para los muertos, ya que ya no pueden rezar por sí mismos. El Papa Francisco dijo que ofrecer la celebración de la Eucaristía para los muertos “es la mejor ayuda espiritual que podemos dar a sus almas, especialmente a las más abandonadas.” **Puedes solicitar una misa en nuestra página web (stmarymagdalenecolumbus.org) o llamando a la Oficina Parroquial. La asignación sugerida para una intención de misa es de 10 dólares.**

**AUGUST 2, 2026 –
EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME
Introduction to the Liturgy of the Day**

Jesus takes us outside again today, to a deserted place where thousands of people followed Him. Despite having only five loaves and two fish, Jesus is able to feed the entire crowd. We gather here every Sunday, a crowd perhaps only in the dozens or hundreds, but where we can all be fed, now with Jesus' own body, offered and multiplied to satisfy us all. We can imagine that we are here with Jesus as He speaks to us and feeds us as He did on that wonderful day, for indeed this is what He does.

THE GRACES THAT COME WITH HAVING A MASS SAID FOR A SPECIAL INTENTION ARE IMMEASURABLE

Since the Catholic Mass is the most powerful form of prayer, it is a common practice to have it offered for a specific intention. Having a Mass said for someone is a powerful way to intercede or pray for them on their behalf. Mass intentions can be requested on behalf of another living person—for example, the healing of someone who is sick or to commemorate a wedding anniversary. However, Mass intentions are most commonly offered in remembrance of a person who has died.

We offer Masses for our deceased loved ones to aid them in their journeys to heaven. We pray with hope that the graces imparted by the Mass usher them further towards eternity with God.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states: “From the beginning, the Church has honored the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the **Eucharistic sacrifice**, so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God” (CCC 1032).

These graces are especially important for the dead, as they can no longer pray for themselves. Pope Francis said that offering the celebration of the Eucharist for the dead “is the best spiritual help that we can give to their souls, particularly to the most abandoned ones.” **You can request a Mass by email (acarrier@saintmarymag.org), on our website (stmarymagdalenecolumbus.org) or by calling the Parish Office. The suggested stipend for a Mass Intention is \$10.00.**

FEAST OF THE TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD – AUGUST 6

The Transfiguration of Jesus is one of the key events in Jesus' life. He took three apostles – Peter, James, and John – up to a high mountain to pray. As they were praying, His appearance changed, and His clothes became “dazzling white.” At that point, Moses and Elijah appeared and spoke to the Lord about His upcoming death. A cloud overshadowed the group, and God the Father's voice came from the cloud saying, “This is my Son, my Chosen; listen to him!”

According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, “Christ's Transfiguration aims at strengthening the apostles' faith in anticipation of his Passion: the ascent on to the ‘high mountain’ prepares for the ascent to Calvary. Christ, Head of the Church, manifests what his Body contains and radiates in the sacraments: ‘the hope of glory’” (CCC 568).

FIESTA DE LA TRANSFIGURACIÓN DEL SEÑOR – 6 DE AGOSTO

La Transfiguración de Jesús es uno de los acontecimientos clave de la vida de Jesús. Él llevó a tres apóstoles – Pedro, Santiago y Juan – a una alta montaña para orar. Mientras estaban orando, su apariencia cambió y sus vestiduras se volvieron «deslumbrantemente blancas». En ese momento, Moisés y Elías aparecieron y hablaron con el Señor acerca de su próxima muerte. Una nube cubrió al grupo, y la voz de Dios Padre salió de la nube diciendo: “Este es mi Hijo, mi Elegido; escúchenlo.”

Según el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, “La Transfiguración de Cristo tiene por finalidad fortalecer la fe de los apóstoles ante la proximidad de la Pasión: la subida a un “monte alto” prepara la subida al Calvario. Cristo, Cabeza de la Iglesia, manifiesta lo que su Cuerpo contiene y hace resplandecer en los sacramentos: “la esperanza de la gloria” (CIC 568).
