Would you like a piece of St. Mary Magdalene or St. Agnes history? On behalf of our parish, Father Héctor donated to the Yard Sale dozens of highly collectible glasses once used in the rectory at St. Mary Magdalene as well as nearly 100 beautiful dinner plates from St. Agnes rectory. We sold a number of these lovely pieces at the Yard Sale, but dozens remain and we would like to offer them to parishioners before selling them on eBay or Facebook Marketplace.

The Dorothy Thorpe barware is likely from the 1940s and features gold-edged glasses in six different sizes. Replacements sell online for up to \$20.00 but our price for parishioners is \$4.00 apiece. The plates are from the Federal Glass Company's iridescent Moonglow collection and date to the 1960s. Online they are selling for \$10.00-15.00, but we are offering them to parishioners for \$2.00 per plate.

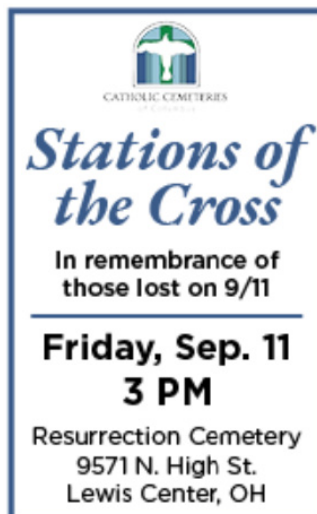
VIGÉSIMO SEGUNDO DOMINGO EN TIEMPO ORDINARIO**Introducción a la Liturgia del Día**

TWENTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**Introduction to the Liturgy of the Day**

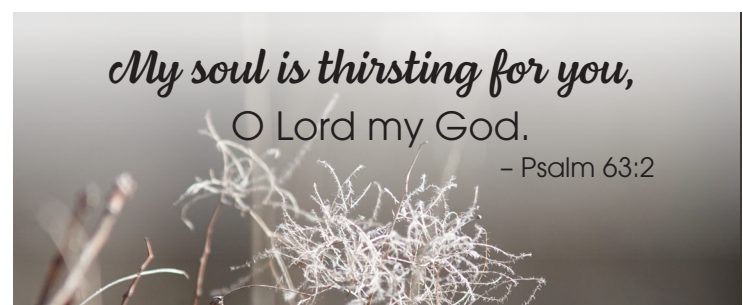
In today's Gospel, Jesus challenges us as His disciples to deny ourselves, take up our crosses, and follow Him. None of these actions is easy. To put God's will before our own, to willingly accept what will make us suffer, and to follow someone who was put to death on the cross, is very difficult. But we will not be alone, for Jesus is with us as we follow Him. Also, as He tells us in the Beatitudes, our reward will be great in heaven. Let us realize His real presence as we celebrate and receive the Eucharist.

Would you like to light a Sanctuary Lamp in memory of a loved one or for a particular intention? Saint Mary Magdalene offers an additional way to memorialize a deceased family member, or to honor or celebrate a special event, by sponsoring the Sanctuary Lamp which hangs by the Tabernacle in Church. Offerings are \$15.00 each. Remembrance begins on Sunday and ends on Saturday of your scheduled week. Place your petitions in the Offertory Basket or mail to the Parish Office. The special intentions for the Lamp will be printed in our weekly bulletin, where we additionally ask our faithful Parishioners to keep those intentions in their prayers.

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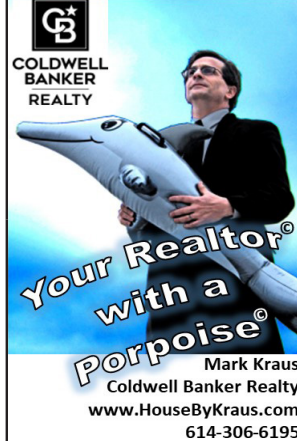
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
