FIESTA DE LA DEDICACIÓN DE LA BASÍLICA DE LETRÁN

Introducción a la Liturgia del Día

La Basílica de Letrán en Roma, el único edificio de la iglesia cuya dedicación se celebra como una fiesta, es un símbolo perdurable de la iglesia universal. En su fachada está inscrito “*omnium urbis et orbis ecclesiarum mater et caput*,” que significa “madre y cabeza de todas las iglesias de la ciudad y del mundo.” Originalmente terminada en el año 324 d.C., poco después de que el emperador Constantino legalizara el cristianismo, la Basílica de Letrán es un signo del triunfo de los fieles que sobrevivieron bajo tierra durante generaciones

cuando los cristianos eran perseguidos. Aunque es probable que estemos reunidos en un entorno mucho más humilde hoy en día, estamos inextricablemente vinculados a esta iglesia histórica: nuestra iglesia madre.

Por eso no toleraría todo lo que veía allí y buscaría acabar con las cosas que convertían ese lugar en un mercado. Las transacciones que realizamos en un marketplace tienen como objetivo un intercambio: dinero por alguna mercancía. El mercado depende del dinero que circula allí para funcionar, y esto puede llevar a los hombres que vinieron al templo a desviar su devoción hacia la mera compra y venta. No podemos tratar nuestra relación con Dios de esta manera; es decir, no podemos venir buscando algo como una transacción, en la que le pido algo a Dios y prometo hacer algo a cambio.

La gracia no se da a través del trueque, sino a través del amor. Si ofrezco algo a Dios, es porque lo ofrezco de corazón y no porque pida algo. A su vez, Dios nos ayuda no porque le daremos algo a cambio, sino porque ve nuestra necesidad y viene en nuestra ayuda.

NOVEMBER 9, 2025 –**FEAST OF THE DEDICATION OF THE LATERAN BASILICA****Introduction to the Liturgy of the Day**

The Lateran Basilica in Rome, the only church building whose dedication is celebrated as a feast, is an enduring symbol of the Universal Church. Inscribed on its façade is "omnium urbis et orbis ecclesiarum mater et caput," meaning, "mother and head of all the churches of the city and of the world." Originally completed in 324 CE, soon after Emperor Constantine legalized Christianity, the Lateran Basilica is a sign of the triumph of the faithful who survived underground for generations when Christians were persecuted. Although we likely are gathered in a much humbler setting today, we are nonetheless inextricably linked to this historic church – our mother church.

FROM THE DESK OF THE PRIEST:

The care Jesus had for the temple, the Father's house, is extremely important. It is the meeting place between God and the people, and therefore it must be cared for in a special way. That is why He would not tolerate everything He saw there and would seek to put an end to the things that turned that place into a marketplace. The transactions we make in a marketplace are aimed at an exchange: money for some merchandise. The marketplace depends on the money that circulates there to function, and this can lead the men who came to the temple to divert their devotion to mere buying and selling. We cannot treat our relationship with God in this way; that is, we cannot come seeking something like a transaction, in which I ask God for something and promise to do something in return.

Grace is not given through bartering, but through love. If I offer something to God, it is because I offer it from the heart and not because I ask for something. In turn, God helps us not because we will give Him something in return, but because He sees our need and comes to our aid.
