SOLEMNITY OF THE NATIVITY OF SAINT JOHN THE BAPTIST: JUNE 24

St. John the Baptist is one of the few saints who have two feast days: one celebrating his birth, June 24, and one remembering his death, August 29.

John the Baptist was set aside and filled with the Holy Spirit, even from his mother's womb (Luke 1:15). He spent his whole life leading others to Christ; his whole existence revolved around preparing the way for Christ. Finally, he was killed by Herod for witnessing to the truth. This is why he is held in such high esteem in the Church. In most artwork depicting the communion of the saints in the Kingdom of God, Our Lady sits on Christ's right, and John on his left.

John challenges us Christians to the fundamental attitude of Christianity—total dependence on the Father, in Christ. Yet the least in the kingdom, Jesus said, is greater than he, for the pure gift that the Father gives. The attractiveness as well as the austerity of John, his fierce courage in denouncing evil—all stem from his fundamental and total placing of his life within the will of God.

A man was sent from God, whose name was John. He came to testify to the light, to prepare a people fit for the Lord.

SOLEMNIDAD DE LA NATIVIDAD DE SAN JUAN BAUTISTA : 24 DE JUNIO

San Juan Bautista es uno de los pocos santos que tiene dos días festivos: uno que celebra su nacimiento, el 24 de junio, y otro que recuerda su muerte, el 29 de agosto. Juan el Bautista fue apartado y lleno del Espíritu Santo, incluso desde el vientre de su madre (Lucas 1:15). Pasó toda su vida guiando a otros a Cristo; toda su existencia giraba en torno a preparar el camino para Cristo. Finalmente, fue asesinado por Herodes por dar testimonio de la verdad. Esta es la razón por la que es tenido en tan alta estima en la Iglesia. En la mayoría de las obras de arte que representan la comunión de los santos en el Reino de Dios, Nuestra Señora está sentada a la derecha de Cristo y Juan a su izquierda. Juan nos desafía a los cristianos a la actitud fundamental del cristianismo: la dependencia total del Padre, en Cristo. Sin embargo, el más pequeño en el reino, dijo Jesús, es más grande que él, por el don puro que el Padre da. El atractivo, así como la austeridad de Juan, su feroz coraje para denunciar el mal, todo se deriva de su colocación fundamental y total de su vida dentro de la voluntad de Dios.

Un hombre fue enviado por Dios, cuyo nombre era Juan. Vino a dar testimonio de la luz, a preparar un pueblo digno del Señor.
