QUESTION OF THE WEEK:

How am I hospitable to others in need of food or rest, or just some companionship? How can I see the Lord in such hospitality?

Desde el escritorio del Sacerdote / From the Desk of the Priest:

¿Qué significa recibir a Jesús en nuestra casa? Tal vez pensemos que recibirlo es abrirle las puertas para que pase y transforme a su entrada todo. Tal vez podemos dirigir la atención en el simple hecho de estar y sentir su presencia con nosotros. Tal vez podemos solo dejar que entre y ocupe un lugar en algún lugar específico de la casa o que tenga alguna función especial frente de ella (como en asistir a un enfermo que tengamos o en hacer que algún familiar cambie). Lo cierto es que aún abriéndole nuestra casa podamos tener efectos nulos a su amor. Es tener a un huésped que algún día tendrá que salir o tener la determinación de que jamás salga. Es por eso que a Jesús no se le puede permitir la entrada sin permitirle amar y entrar en acción transformando todo y a todos a su paso. Es dejarnos moldear por Él. A veces los que están "más cerca" de Él son los que necesitan más de Él y su amor. Dejémosle entrar a nuestra casa pero permitámosle hacer lo que Él desee, no indicándole lo que tiene qué hacer y por dónde caminar dentro del hogar.

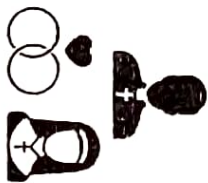
What does it mean to welcome Jesus into our home? Perhaps we think that welcoming Him means opening the doors for Him to enter and transform everything upon His entrance. Perhaps we can focus our attention on the simple fact of being and feeling His presence with us. Perhaps we can simply allow Him to enter and occupy a specific place in the house or have a special function in it (such as caring for a sick person or helping a family member change). The truth is that even opening our home to Him can have no effect on His love. It's like having a guest who will one day have to leave or being determined never to leave. That's why Jesus cannot be allowed in without allowing Him to love and take action, transforming everything and everyone in His path. It means allowing ourselves to be molded by Him. Sometimes those who are "closest" to Him are those who need Him and His love the most. Let's let Him enter our home, but let's allow Him to do what He wants, not tell Him what to do and where to walk within the home.

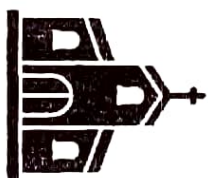

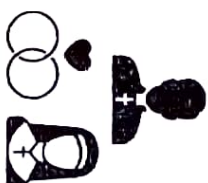

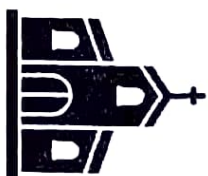

THE FEAST DAY OF OUR PATRON SAINT, MARY MAGDALENE!

We will celebrate the Feast Day of
St. Mary Magdalene with Mass at 7:00 p.m.
on Tuesday, July 22nd
followed by Dessert Potluck in the Church Hall.
Bring your favorite dessert or snack to share!

St. Mary Magdalene, whose feast day is on July 22, was one of Jesus' most celebrated disciples, famous, according to Mark 16:9–10 and John 20:14–17, for being the first person to see the resurrected Christ. The unchallenged facts about her life establish that Jesus cleansed her of seven demons (Luke 8:2 and Mark 16:9), probably implying that He cured her of a physical disorder rather than the popular notion that He freed her of evil spirits.

In our Feast Day display, we have the beautiful Icon commissioned and painted by an artist for our parish. A skull is placed nearby, which reminds us of her role as a witness to the crucifixion at Golgotha, the “place of the skull.” A jar to reference the spices and aloe used to anoint the body of Jesus is also present.

Having seen where Jesus was buried (Mark 15:47), Mary Magdalene went with two other women on Easter morning to the tomb to anoint the corpse. Finding the tomb empty, Mary Magdalene ran to the disciples. She returned with St. Peter, who, astonished, left her. Christ then appeared to Mary Magdalene and, according to John 20:17, instructed her to tell the Apostles that He was ascending to God.

Saint Mary Magdalene, woman of many sins, who by conversion became the beloved of Jesus and remained at His cross, thank you for your witness that Jesus forgives through the miracle of love. You, who already possess eternal happiness in His glorious presence, please intercede for me, so that one day I may share in the same everlasting joy.
