

## SANTA TERESA DE CALCUTA

Santa del día: 5 de septiembre

Patrona de la Jornada Mundial de la Juventud y de las Misioneras de la Caridad

Nacida de padres albaneses en lo que hoy es Skopje, Macedonia, Gonxha (Agnes) Bojaxhiu era la menor de los tres hijos que sobrevivieron. Durante sus años en la escuela pública, Agnes participó en una cofradía católica y mostró un gran interés por las misiones en el extranjero. A los 18 años, ingresó en las Hermanas de Loreto de Dublín. Al año siguiente fue enviada al noviciado de Loreto en Darjeeling, India. Allí eligió el nombre de Teresa y se preparó para una vida de servicio. Fue asignada a una escuela secundaria para niñas en Calcutta, donde enseñó historia y geografía a las hijas de los ricos. Pero no podía escapar de la realidad que la rodeaba: la pobreza, el sufrimiento, el abrumador número de personas indigentes.

En 1946, mientras viajaba en tren a Darjeeling para hacer un retiro, la hermana Teresa escuchó lo que más tarde describió como "una llamada dentro de otra llamada." El mensaje era claro. Debía abandonar el convento y ayudar a los pobres viviendo entre ellos.

Regresó a Calcutta, donde vivió en los barrios marginales y abrió una escuela para niños pobres. Vestida con un sari blanco y sandalias, la vestimenta habitual de una mujer india, pronto comenzó a conocer a sus vecinos, especialmente a los pobres y enfermos, y a conocer sus necesidades a través de sus visitas.

En 1952, la ciudad de Calcutta le dio a la Madre Teresa un antiguo albergue, que se convirtió en un hogar para los moribundos y los indigentes. A medida que la orden se expandía, también se ofrecían servicios a huérfanos, niños abandonados, alcohólicos, ancianos y personas sin hogar.

Durante las siguientes cuatro décadas, la Madre Teresa trabajó incansablemente en favor de los pobres. Recorrió el mundo pidiendo apoyo e invitando a otros a ver el rostro de Jesús en los más pobres entre los pobres. En 1979, le fue otorgado el Premio Nobel de la Paz. El 5 de septiembre de 1997, Dios la llamó a su lado. La beata Teresa fue canonizada por el papa Francisco el 4 de septiembre de 2017.

## SAINT TERESA OF CALCUTTA

Saint of the Day: September 5

Patron Saint of World Youth Day and The Missionaries of Charity

Born to Albanian parents in what is now Skopje, Macedonia, Gonxha (Agnes) Bojaxhiu was the youngest of the three children who survived. During her years in public school, Agnes participated in a Catholic sodality and showed a strong interest in the foreign missions. At age 18, she entered the Loreto Sisters of Dublin. The following year she was sent to the Loreto novitiate in Darjeeling, India. There she chose the name Teresa and prepared for a life of service. She was assigned to a high school for girls in Calcutta, where she taught history and geography to the daughters of the wealthy. But she could not escape the realities around her – the poverty, the suffering, the overwhelming numbers of destitute people. In 1946, while riding a train to Darjeeling to make a retreat, Sister Teresa heard what she later explained as "a call within a call. The message was clear. I was to leave the convent and help the poor while living among them."

She returned to Calcutta, where she lived in the slums and opened a school for poor children. Dressed in a white sari and sandals – the ordinary dress of an Indian woman – she soon began getting to know her neighbors – especially the poor and sick – and getting to know their needs through visits.

In 1952, the city of Calcutta gave Mother Teresa a former hostel, which became a home for the dying and the destitute. As the order expanded, services were also offered to orphans, abandoned children, alcoholics, the aging, and street people. For the next four decades, Mother Teresa worked tirelessly on behalf of the poor. She crisscrossed the globe pleading for support and inviting others to see the face of Jesus in the poorest of the poor. In 1979, she was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize. On September 5, 1997, God called her home. Blessed Teresa was canonized by Pope Francis on September 4, 2016.


