UPCOMING ITEMS OF INTEREST AT ST. MARY MAGDALENE...**SUNDAY MORNING, JANUARY 28TH**

Father Slawek will preside over Holy Mass (9:00 a.m.) at Saint Mary Magdalene, during which he will administer the Sacrament of Baptism to six students from Saint Mary Magdalene School. Please pray for them – to give them strength and that they will be a new disciple of Jesus to the world.

FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 2ND is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, a day when the Church blesses candles. It is a day when all the Religious Community renew their vow to be a servant to Christ and to the people. It is a vow of poverty, obedience and chastity. Please remember them in your personal prayer to encourage more young people to dedicate their life to Jesus. We also walk in procession at church, carrying a lit candle, with the invitation, “Let us go in peace to meet the Lord,” which is a rich – and even astounding – summary of this Feast Day.

FEBRUARY 3RD is the memorial of St. Blaise, the traditional day for the blessing of throats. The custom comes from a time when the entire year was filled with blessings. As the year unfolded, the Church offered up the whole of creation to bless the Lord. We will bless throats after the Masses on the weekend of February 3rd and 4th.

La Misa une a la Iglesia en la tierra con la Iglesia en el cielo. Las intenciones de la Misa son elevadas por el Cuerpo de Cristo en su totalidad.

**THE GRACES THAT COME WITH
HAVING A MASS SAID FOR A
SPECIAL INTENTION ARE
IMMEASURABLE.**

Since the Catholic Mass is the most powerful form of prayer, it is a common practice to have it offered for a specific intention. Having a Mass said for someone is a powerful way to intercede or pray for them on their behalf. Mass Intentions can be requested on behalf of another living person – for example, the healing of someone who is sick or to commemorate a wedding anniversary. However, Mass Intentions are most commonly offered in remembrance of a person who has died.

We offer Masses for our deceased loved ones to aid them in their journeys to heaven. We pray with hope that the graces imparted by the Mass usher them further towards eternity with God.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states: "From the beginning, the Church has honored the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the **Eucharistic sacrifice**, so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God" (CCC 1032).

The Mass unites the Church on earth to the Church in heaven. The intentions of the Mass are lifted by the Body of Christ in its entirety.

These graces are especially important for the dead, as they can no longer pray for themselves. Pope Francis said that offering the celebration of the Eucharist for the dead "is the best spiritual help that we can give to their souls, particularly to the most abandoned ones."

We are currently scheduling Mass Intentions for 2024. You can request a Mass by email at acarrier@saintmarymag.org, on our website (stmarymagdalenebaltimore.org) or by calling the Parish Office. The suggested stipend for a Mass Intention is \$10.00.


