**What is a “Spiritual Communion”?**

The Eucharistic Liturgy is the summit of the church's worship. It is a Sacramental Communion with God, the Father, through the Son, Jesus Christ, in the Holy Spirit. **For Catholics watching our livestream**, who are unable to be physically present in church to receive the Sacrament, there is a Spiritual Communion in and with Jesus Christ. We should prepare for a spiritual communion in the same way we prepare to receive Jesus in the Eucharist. We should mentally collect our thoughts and prepare our hearts as best we can. Anytime Catholics are unable to receive the Eucharist, they can make an act of Spiritual Communion.

**During the time Fr. Slawek is preparing to distribute Communion to our congregation, the lector will read the *Prayer of Spiritual Communion*.**



**ANOINTING OF THE SICK, CAREY, OHIO**

For the past five years, the Columbus Region of the Order of Malta has sponsored an Annual Mass for the Anointing of the Sick on the second Sunday of February. On Sunday, February 11, 2024, the Church celebrates the Feast Day of Our Lady of Lourdes and the World Day of the Sick. The Order is sponsoring a Pilgrimage to the Basilica of Our Lady of Consolation in Carey, OH to join Bishop Earl Fernandes as he celebrates Mass and offers the Sacrament of Anointing. The Order is chartering an ADA certified bus to take those who wish to receive the Anointing of the Sick and a companion to Carey. ### SUNDAY MORNING, JANUARY 28TH

Father Slawek will preside over Holy Mass (9:00 a.m.) at Saint Mary Magdalene, during which he will administer the Sacrament of Baptism to six students from Saint Mary Magdalene School. Please pray for them – to give them strength and that they will be a new disciple of Jesus to the world.

**FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 2ND** is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, a day when the Church blesses candles. It is a day when all the Religious Community renews their vow to be a servant to Christ, and to the people. It is a vow of poverty, obedience and chastity. Please remember them in your personal prayer to encourage more young people to dedicate their life to Jesus. We also walk in procession at church, carrying a lit candle, with the invitation, “Let us go in peace to meet the Lord,” which is a rich, and even astounding, summary of this feast day.

**FEBRUARY 3RD** is the memorial of St. Blaise, the traditional day for the Blessing of Throats. The custom comes from a time when the entire year was filled with blessings. As the year unfolded, the Church offered up the whole of creation to bless the Lord. We will bless throats after the Masses on the weekend of February 3rd and 4th.
