Ash Wednesday is the first day of Lent and it occurs forty-six days (forty days not counting Sundays) before Easter. It is a moveable feast because it is dependent on the Sunday of Easter.

The ashes used are gathered from the Palms from the previous Palm Sunday. They are burned and mixed with sacred oils. The priest makes a sign of the cross on the forehead of the congregants and recites the words: "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return."

A basket is in the Gathering Space for the collection of previous years' blessed palms to burn for Ashes.


