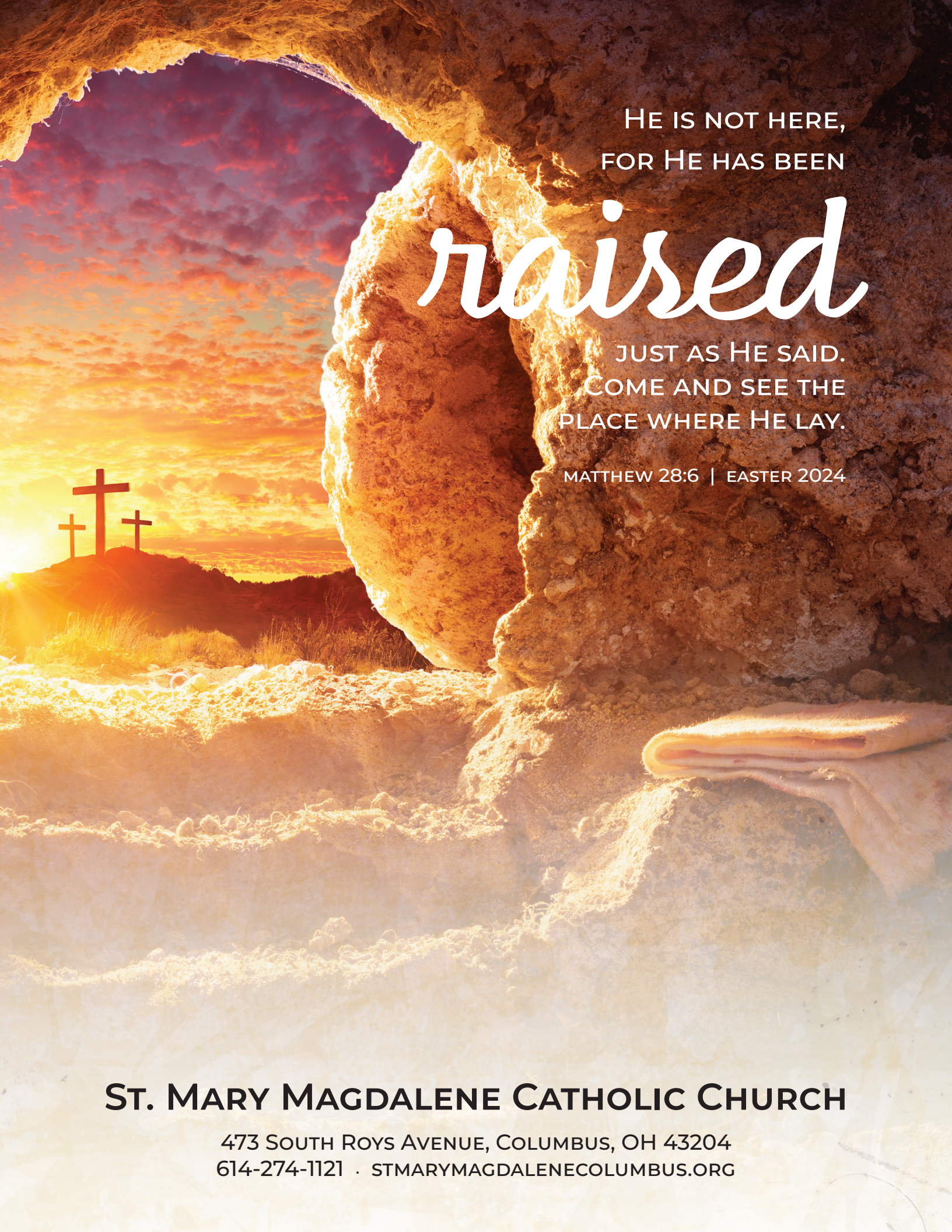

RESPUESTA

Reflexión sobre Lucas 24:35-48

A lo largo de las Escrituras, el hambre no sólo se refiere a la realidad física – nuestra necesidad humana de alimento-, sino que también se utiliza como metáfora de nuestras necesidades humanas más profundas – de conexión, comprensión, aceptación, perdón, amor. En Jesús, el Resucitado, se nos da la verdadera satisfacción de todas nuestras hambres. Él es el Pan de Vida, que nos sostiene a través de su presencia real en la Eucaristía; ¡nos alimenta física y espiritualmente!

Como en otras apariciones de la Resurrección, este relato evangélico retrata a los discípulos “aterrorizados” y “sobresaltados,” así como “asombrados” e “incrédulos de alegría.” A través de estas respuestas humanas a la extraordinaria verdad de que, efectivamente, Jesús ha resucitado, los discípulos son enviados como testigos. Lo mismo ocurre con nosotros. Cuando las Escrituras se abren para nosotros, cuando nuestras hambres son alimentadas por Cristo, cuando somos sorprendidos por la gracia, asombrados por la misericordia, incrédulos de alegría, incluso aterrorizados por la grandeza del amor de Dios – todos estos encuentros nos impulsarán a la misión, porque lo que se ha recibido como don debe entregarse como don.

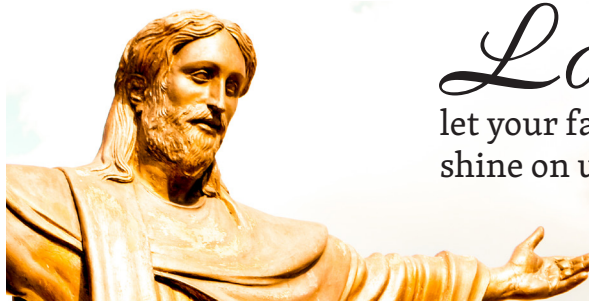


SCHOOL NEWS

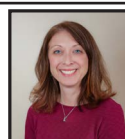
